
Do you Love me? Feed my sheep.

In this Sunday's Gospel (**Matthew 4:12-23**) we find that Jesus "... went around all of Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and curing every disease and illness among the people."

Every encounter with Jesus elicits a response; today's gospel shows a response of discipleship that is quick and decisive. Our own call to discipleship comes at our baptism...we practice following Jesus in the simple, everyday things that come our way: the friend who needs a listening ear, the parent who needs a comforting phone call, the sick child who interrupts our sleep. As Vincentians we respond when a Neighbor in Need calls. One such contact a few months ago led to us working with Walking with Moms in Need and the Knights of Columbus to provide food, shelter and support for a young pregnant mother and her two children following their flight from a domestic violence situation.


