

## OLV School News

### ELA News from Middle School



Great learning is happening in 7th- and 8th-grade ELA classes this year! In Grammar and Writing, the 6th graders have just finished the first half of

their verbs unit on the progressive and perfect tenses. The 7th- and 8th-grade students have completed their units on researching topics and connecting them to social justice principles and are currently studying adjectives and adverbs.

In two weeks, they begin researching again – this time for their debates. They are giving great effort into mastering important skills, such as finding evidence to support their ideas and developing their writing voices.

In 6th-grade literature, they are reading *The Watsons Go to Birmingham* as part of their historical fiction unit. This novel is the first step towards nonfiction texts, which they will begin next quarter. Currently, the 7th graders are reading *Warriors Don't Cry*, an autobiographical text that allows them to engage in wider conversations about justice and fairness, as well as how to approach perspectives different from their own.

The 8th graders are completing their nonfiction unit and preparing for their next unit of study on Holocaust literature, a cross-curricular unit with social studies. They will visit the Zekelman Holocaust Center in February.

## Sensory Kits Available

We understand that the sights, sounds, and structure of the liturgy can sometimes be overwhelming for some children. These sensory kits offer quiet, respectful tools to help children remain calm, attentive, and present during the celebration of the Eucharist.

Each kit includes items such as a book about the Mass, soft fidget tools and calming sensory supports that may be used discreetly in the pews. These items are intended to assist children in focusing and participating more fully in the Mass while maintaining reverence for the sacred liturgy.

Families are welcome to borrow a sensory kit before Mass and return it afterward so that others may also benefit. The navy blue bags are located on the rack in the Gathering Space. Look for the yellow OLV Sensory Kit stitching on the front.
