Key Concept: The Seven Sacraments are effective signs, instituted by Christ, that give grace and continue his saving work in the world. The Sacrament of the Eucharist is at the heart of Christian life.

- Sacraments are special signs and celebrations that come from Jesus and allows us to share in God's life and love.
 - God the Father sent His only son, Jesus, as a sign of His love for His people.
- Each of the Seven Sacraments are effective signs of God's life, instituted by Christ and given to the Church, so that Jesus can continue His saving work in the world.
- The visible signs and Divine actions in each celebration give grace and allow us to share in God's work.

 - Living the Eucharist means continuing Jesus 'work in the world! Eucharist is the Sacrament in which Jesus gives of Himself and the bread and wine become His Body and Blood.
