

Sixth Grade-Lesson 1-Introduction to the Bible

This year we will be studying the Bible. We will be studying the story of Salvation History.

- Have you had a chance to study the Bible outside of church?
- What stories from the Bible do you remember or are your favorite stories?

We have this program called “Encounter” that was designed just for your age group so you can get a good overview of the Bible and understand what you’ll find in it and also to talk about the actual timeline of the Bible. We will be using the book, “Encounter” and complete the worksheets that go with the week’s lesson as well as watching the video with Mark Hart. Mark is a little goofy at times, but he has a great message so even though it’s a video I really hope you will listen. After the video you will answer some questions about the video.

Let’s start with the Fill- in- the- Blanks on page 5 and read pages 6 and 7 of the book “Encounter.”

Read pages 8-9 and answer the questions at the bottom of page 9.

- When have felt inspired? What was the situation? Who or What inspired you? What were you inspired to notice, do, feel, or change?
