

## **Sixth Grade-Lesson 4-Exodus (4-40)-Desert Wanderings (Numbers)-Conquest & Judges Joshua, Judges, 1 Samuel 1-8)**

**Key Points:** We have learned about the Early World when we talked about Genesis. We talked about the Patriarchs Abraham & Sarah, Isaac, Jacob and Joseph and we talked about Egypt and the Exodus led by Moses. Today's video is going to continue with the story of Moses and the 10 Commandments and continue through the book of Numbers and the desert wanderings. We'll also learn about Joshua and Judges. God gave us the 10 Commandments because he loves us. They are a guide for how to live and can help provide an examination of how we are living and what things we need to work on in our lives.
