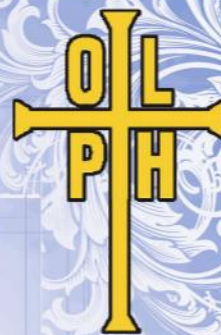

Sacraments



SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM: Baptisms are usually celebrated on the fourth Sunday of the month following the 10:30 a.m. Mass. Parents and godparents are required to attend a seminar prior to the Baptism. The seminar is held on the third Monday of the month at 7:00 p.m. in the Day Chapel in Church. More information and required forms can be found on our website. (Baptisms are not celebrated during Lent.)

SACRAMENT OF FIRST COMMUNION: First Eucharist is celebrated the first Saturday of May for students in the 2nd grade or above. Children older than 2nd grade will be prepared on individual situations.

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION: Confirmation is celebrated in the Fall of 11th grade. Candidates who attend Catholic high school or are enrolled in the High School of Religion program come together for Sacramental preparation. All candidates are asked to pre-register in their freshmen year and no later than December of their 10th grade year. Information and registration can be found on our website: www.olphbc.org.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE: Contact the Church Office at least nine months prior to the planned date. No other arrangements should be made before contacting the Church Office.

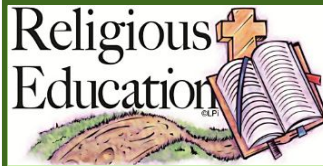

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION:

PARISH SCHOOL OF RELIGION: PSR classes for students in Kindergarten through 8th grade not attending a Catholic school, are offered on Tuesday or Wednesday during the school year from 4:45—6:00 p.m.

HIGH SCHOOL OF RELIGION: Students in 9th through 12th grade not attending a Catholic High School are offered classes on Sunday evenings 5:30-6:45 p.m. in the KC Hall.

RCIA: Are you or someone you know interested in becoming Catholic or completing Sacraments? Please join our RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). We have a Year-Round RCIA process that you can enter into whenever you are ready. This is for you if you have never been baptized, if you have been baptized into another denomination and now want to become Catholic, or if you are an adult Catholic but have never been confirmed. St. Therese of Lisieux



The entire family of St. Therese of Lisieux, the Little Flower, had a great devotion to the Eucharist. Her father was granted the opportunity to receive communion more than once a week. Therese often went to daily Mass with her father as a young girl. Her devotion to the Blessed Sacrament was demonstrated by her frequent visits of Adoration when she was not able to attend daily Mass. She was often a part of Eucharistic processions and was excited if one of the flower petals she threw would touch the Monstrance. She had the desire to receive her First Holy Communion when her older sister, Celine, received hers, but was not allowed because of her age.

Celine remembered that on the day of her First Communion: "Therese looked at me with a kind of holy respect and hardly dared to touch me." Therese remembered Celine's First Communion as "one of the most beautiful days of her life". Therese was finally able to receive communion herself at 11 years old. To prepare herself for the sacrament she would spend her 15 minutes of recreation time from school in the chapel where her desire for the Eucharist grew. After her First Communion her response was: "How sweet was that first kiss of Jesus!" She looked forward to every opportunity to consume the host.

St. Therese became a Carmelite at the age of 15 after getting special permission from the pope to enter the order. However, she was denied receiving communion frequently because the abbess of the convent did not allow the nuns this option. According to Therese's sister, Marie, this became her main source of suffering. As a result Therese took this to prayer. She had a devotion to St. Joseph so she brought this issue to him. Her prayer was answered.

Therese enjoyed the ministry of aide to the sacristan at the convent. She felt privileged to touch the sacred vessels, but obediently only when she was directed to do so. She was observed to be very reverent when doing her duties.

As Therese became sick, the desire to receive the Eucharist never diminished. She forced herself to attend Mass and would delay her medicine until after Mass was over. She declared: "The best means to reach perfection is through receiving Holy Communion frequently."

St. Therese died at the age of 24 and is the patron saint of florists, missionaries, pilots, and priests. Her feast day is October 1.

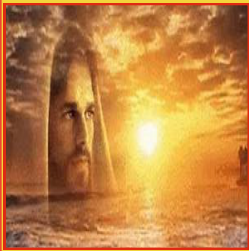
