

My dear parishioners,

On this second Sunday of Lent, we hear St. Matthew's account of the Transfiguration of the Lord (Mt 17:1-9). In paragraph 556 of the Catechism of the Catholic Church, we read that "the Transfiguration gives us a foretaste of Christ's glorious coming, when he 'will change our lowly body to be like his glorious body' (Phil 3:21). But it also recalls that 'it is through many persecutions that we must enter the kingdom of God' (Acts 14:22)." Before his coming passion and death, Christ gives to Peter, James, and John a glimpse of his coming resurrection. They receive the unique spiritual consolation of witnessing Christ's Transfiguration on Mt. Tabor to strengthen their hearts for the coming spiritual desolation they will experience with Christ's crucifixion on Mt. Calvary. St. Ignatius of Loyola succinctly articulated this idea, when he wrote in his Spiritual Exercises: "let the one who is in consolation think how he will conduct himself in the desolation which will come after, taking new strength for that time" (323).

The fact that the cross must precede the resurrection, that suffering must come before glory, is something we must understand and be reminded of again and again in our spiritual lives. The *Catechism* (n. 556) quotes St. Augustine who said: "Peter did not yet understand this when he wanted to remain with Christ on the mountain. It has been reserved for you, Peter, but for after death. For now, Jesus says: 'Go down to toil on earth, to serve on earth, to be scorned and crucified on earth. Life goes down to be killed; Bread goes down to suffer hunger; the Way goes down to be exhausted on his journey; the Spring goes down to suffer thirst; and you refuse to suffer?'" May the grace of Our Lord's Transfiguration on Mt. Tabor strengthen us to follow him up Mt. Calvary. And, as we do, let us not forget that Good Friday is the path to Easter Sunday.
