# Bishop David Malloy to Celebrate Mass for Life January 22nd. at 6:30pm at St. Mary's, Huntley, IL.

Traditionally at this time of year, the diocese along with a variety of schools and parishes would be preparing for a pilgrimage to the annual March for Life in Washington, Jan. 27-29.

But like most other large gatherings, the annual March is being overshadowed by the coronavirus and concerns for health and safety of those who would participate. Even though the March will still take place, most events are being held virtually. Most dioceses are not sponsoring group travel including the Rockford Diocese. But with the coordination of the Life and Family Evangelization Office and Father Christopher DiTomo, along with his parish team at St. Mary Huntley, a Mass for Life will be celebrated in person by Bishop Malloy and streamed to the public from the parish. The Mass will be celebrated at St. Mary Parish, Huntley on January 22nd at 6:30pm. Under diocesan protocols during the current pandemic, the parish can accommodate a maximum of 300 persons. Dear Brothers and Sisters,

In December, Pope Francis declared The Year of St. Joseph. As with the other years, like the Year of Mercy, or the Year of St. Paul in the past, there are opportunities to obtain plenary indulgences. A definition from Catholic Culture about plenary indulgences reads, "An indulgence that can remove all the temporal punishment due to forgiven sin. No one but God knows for certain when a plenary indulgences is actually gained, because only he knows whether a person's dispositions are adequate."

Below I have included bits of the text from the Apostolic Penitentiary, the ones responsible for communicating the requirements for this year.

The plenary indulgence is granted under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer according to the intentions of the Holy Father) to the faithful who, with a spirit detached from any sin, participate in the Year of Saint Joseph on the occasions and in the manner indicated by this Apostolic Penitentiary.

- a. The plenary Indulgence is granted to those who meditate for at least 30 minutes on the Lord's Prayer, or who participate in a spiritual retreat of at least one day that includes a meditation on Saint Joseph;
- b. Those who, following the example of Saint Joseph, perform a corporal or spiritual work of mercy, will also be able to obtain the gift of plenary Indulgence;
- c. So that all Christian families are encouraged to recreate the same atmosphere of intimate communion, love and prayer that was lived in the Holy Family, the Plenary Indulgence is granted for the recitation of the Holy Rosary in families and between the bride and groom.
- d. All those who entrust their work daily to the protection of Saint Joseph and all believers who invoke with their prayers the intercession of the worker of Nazareth, so that they may obtain plenary indulgence. who are looking for work find it and everyone's work is more dignified.
- e. The flight of the Holy Family to Egypt "shows us God is where man is in danger, where man suffers, where he flees, where he experiences rejection and abandonment". Plenary indulgence is granted to the faithful who pray the litary of Saint Joseph (for the Latin tradition), or some other prayer to Saint Joseph, typical of the other liturgical traditions, in favor of the Church persecuted ad intra and ad extra and for the relief of all Christians who suffer all forms of persecution.

I will offer more resources in future bulletins but I hope that this explains what needs to be done to obtain indulgences throughout the year.


