GENERAL STATEMENT OF JOB: All Saints Catholic School is seeking a full-time middle school teacher for the 2023-2024 school year. Special consideration will be given to those with ELA/Literature backgrounds; however, teachers with all specialties are encouraged to apply as the successful candidate may teach a variety of subjects and grade levels (5th, 6th, and 7th) at our middle building. The successful candidate is dedicated to the whole-child philosophy and committed to helping students grow their faith, knowledge, and social skills.

Salary ranges from \$40,008 - \$70,978 annually. Offered salary is based on Diocesan-wide pay for certain positions, internal equity, market data, applicant's skills and relevant experience, degrees, and certifications. This position receives a comprehensive benefits package including medical, dental, life and long-term disability insurance, 401(a) and 403(b), state-paid medical and family leave, and sick leave.
