A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

I think it is a good idea to write again about the Extraordinary Holy Year of Mercy which we are now living, but first a word about Holy Years in general.

The tradition of special Holy Years goes back to 1300 A.D. when Pope Boniface VIII desired to bring back an Old Testament custom in which debts were forgiven and slaves freed. The Pope wanted to transform the Holy Year unto a spiritual year of remission. At first, they occurred every 100 years, then 50 and, in 1974, Pope Paul VI decided they should take place every 25 years, as well as on special occasions or anniversaries.

For many centuries, the only Holy Doors during Holy Years were in Rome. The idea was that a person had to make a symbolic pilgrimage to pass through the Door from sin into grace. In 1999, Pope (Saint) John Paul II decided that there should be other Holy Doors during Holy Years as well. This Jubilee Year from December 8, 2015 to November 20, 2016 is called a Holy Year of Mercy to once again stress God's forgiveness but also His mercy and love for us (the reason for His forgiveness). With Holy Doors in every Cathedral in the world and many other churches and shrines, there are currently more than 10,000 Holy Doors for Catholics all around the world to visit as on a pilgrimage and repent of sin to receive the Jubilee Indulgence. The Holy Father's wish is that the..."Indulgence may reach each one as a genuine experience of God's mercy, which comes to meet each person in the Face of the Father, who welcomes and forgives, forgetting completely the sin committed."

To receive the Indulgence, one has to be resolved to have nothing to do with sin; go to confession; receive Holy Communion; visit a Holy Door (eg. St. Patrick's Cathedral or the Marian Shrine in Stony Point) and say some prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father (like one Our Father and one Hail Mary). All of the above within 20 days of visiting the Door.

Much more could be written, but it suffices to say Jesus wants us to turn away from sin and receive His grace and mercy because of His love for us.
