Dear Parishioners,

I have written over 500 notes or letters for the bulletin over the last ten years with the hope of keeping you informed and wanting to communicate with as many of you as possible. I know that not everyone reads the bulletin but many of you have said you have appreciated the weekly column.

I have also tried to greet as many people as possible at Sunday Masses. Occasionally, I could not be at the door but I kept those times to a minimum. In fact, I could only be at one of the two doors after Mass so that sometimes I would go weeks without at least seeing some parishioners.

Eventually, I served on a number of Archdiocesan committees like the Priests' Council, the Regional Catholic School Board, Catholic Community Services of Rockland, the Liturgical Commission of the Archdiocese as well as the Cardinal Cooke Guild, in addition to subcommittees. I know these duties took me away from the parish at times, but I was never really away for long. I always took as many days on duty (on call) in the parish as the other priests assigned here. I sought to be present to the children in Sacred Heart School and the Religious Education Program as best I could. I also tried to visit all the various groups in the parish as often as possible.

Of course, the celebration of the Mass and the other sacraments are at the center of life for me and for the parish.

I guess I am trying to say I did my best to serve everyone here at Sacred Heart for ten years. I know I have fallen short many times, and I wish I could have done more to bring the message of the Gospel to everyone.

I am consoled to know that Jesus makes up for our shortcomings with His love, mercy and grace. I thank Him for guiding us and blessing us all. I promise my prayers and pledge my love. God bless always!
