# FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT APRIL 2, 2017

#### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

As we come to the Fifth Sunday of Lent, baseball season has finally arrived with the Yankees opening on the road tonight. Now, don't be alarmed. I do realize that Lent has not been a time to prepare for the baseball season, but for something infinitely greater. We are only a week away from Holy Week, the week that changed the world.

In today's powerful Gospel of the raising of Lazarus from the dead, Jesus goes to the tomb of Lazarus on His way to Jerusalem to face His Passion. The raising of Lazarus from the dead is a sign that points toward something far greater: the Resurrection of Jesus from the dead. Lazarus, after all, was merely given back his mortal life and would die again. But the Resurrection of Jesus destroyed the power of death forever. And Jesus extends His victory over death to all those who believe in Him: "I am the Resurrection and the Life. He who believes in me even if he dies will live, and he who lives and believes in me will never die."

Resurrection and Eternal Life are not just abstract concepts, but Jesus, Himself, is the Resurrection and the Life. "I am the Resurrection and the Life." The promise of Resurrection and Eternal Life begins with our relationship with Jesus and our sharing in His Divine Life right here and now, which began at our Baptism and is nourished and deepened by the other Sacraments, culminating with the Eucharist as we receive the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of the Risen Jesus.

The Sacraments are the ways in which Easter is brought home to us personally as we pass over with Jesus from sin to Grace, from death to Eternal Life. And when we slip back into sin and death, we make this "passover" again with Jesus in the beautiful Sacrament of Reconciliation, which the Church Fathers called a Second Baptism. A good Confession not only obtains forgiveness of our sins, but replenishes our Souls with Sanctifying Grace and restores them to the beauty they had on the day of our Baptism. As Jesus said, "I make all things new." May we make a good Confession an essential part of our Lenten preparation so that we can celebrate the Joy of Easter with minds and hearts made new. May God bless us all.
