A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

We are in this glorious Easter Season after a beautiful and powerful Holy Week. What a joy it was to see so many come to our Church during Holy Week for the Liturgies of the Easter Triduum, and the hundreds who came for Confession throughout that blessed week, as well as the overflowing crowds in the Church and School Auditorium on Easter Sunday.

There are so many to thank who worked so hard to make Easter here so beautiful. The music throughout the Easter Triduum was so uplifting thanks to Mary Peden and our dedicated choir members who lifted our minds and hearts to Heaven. Thank you to our Lectors, our Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, our Ushers, and our dedicated Altar Servers who carried out their respective ministries with such reverence and devotion. It was so good to have Walter Genito with us, who was home from the Seminary for the Easter Triduum, who prepared the altar servers and guided them through all the Triduum Liturgies. Thank you, too, to Christine Schnabel who works so hard behind the scenes with our staff in facilitating everything that happens here, and, of course, to Henry Antonucci who prepared the flowers in the sanctuary so beautifully for Easter along with tending to all the details in making our Liturgies go so smoothly. I also want to thank Father Innocent for his wonderful talks throughout Lent and for all he did to make our Easter Triduum Liturgies so prayerful. He is such a blessing to our Parish. And thank you to all of you for all you do for this Parish in keeping it so vibrant and strong, and for making it such a beautiful place to be.

On this Octave Day of Easter we celebrate *Divine Mercy Sunday.* This beautiful and powerful devotion to our Lord's Mercy came out of private revelations to a cloister nun in Poland, Sister Faustina, during the 1920's and 1930's when there were so many manifestations of evil going on in the world. Saint John Paul II canonized Sister Faustina on the Second Sunday of Easter in 2000, and at that time instituted this Feast of Divine Mercy to be celebrated each year on the Second Sunday of Easter. The Divine Mercy message re-presents for our times the most fundamental teaching of the Gospel, imploring us to trust in God's Mercy, to seek His Mercy especially in the Sacrament of Penance, and then to extend that mercy to others by forgiving one another as Christ has forgiven us and dedicating ourselves to works of Mercy.

Today we continue to see so much evil in our world as much or more than ever before. We need to implore the Mercy of God *"in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world,"* as we pray in the Divine Mercy Chaplet. As Saint John Paul II put it, *"God has placed a limit on evil in the world: Divine Mercy."* Indeed, our Lord revealed to Saint Faustina that: *"The world will never find Peace until it turns to my Mercy."* Let us do so with renewed trust today and always, keeping that beautiful and simple Divine Mercy prayer always in our hearts and on our lips: **"Jesus, I trust in You."** May God bless us all.
