Dear Parishioners:

It is always such an inspiration to see the hundreds of thousands of people peacefully and prayerfully standing up for life at the "March for Life" in Washington, DC. As I write this letter the March is scheduled to take place on Friday, January 19th. This year marks the 45<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Roe vs Wade. Every year this is such an extraordinary event for which people come not only from across this County, but from around the world, so many of them young people and families. Unfortunately, but not surprisingly, there is usually little or no coverage by the mainstream media. Francis put it: "Every unborn child, condemned unjustly to being aborted, has the face of the Lord...they are conceived in His image and likeness...they cannot be discarded!" It is clear that this Truth is alive and well in so many of the hearts of our young people throughout this land, and no doubt will ultimately prevail.

Indeed our commitment to the sanctity of human life does not stop with life in the womb but extends through natural death and at every point in That is why we are participating in another "pro-life" endeavor going on throughout the Archdiocese of New York beginning next weekend called the "Feeding our Neighbors" food drive. As the Christmas season of giving is over and we are in the midst of the coldest time of year, food pantries are in great need of replenishing their supplies for the poor and homeless, including so many families and children in our midst in this Archdiocese. There are so many opportunities every day to do the "Corporal Works of Mercy," to reverence the image of God in each and every one of our fellow human beings.

On a final note, we are entering into the home stretch of our 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Year of Celebration. Please plan on being a part of it and lending a helping hand if you can. The year will culminate with a closing Mass of Thanksgiving on June 8<sup>th</sup>, the Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, with Archbishop Charles Balvo, the Papal Nuncio to Kenya, who grew up in this Parish and graduated from our School. He will also be an honoree at the Gala Dinner Dance the following

evening at the Crowne Plaza. And before this, on Good Friday, March 30<sup>th</sup>, there will be a very moving and spectacular outdoor living Stations of the Cross and Passion Play which will begin with a procession with an 18 foot Cross up Lafayette Avenue to the Church parking lot.

I hope and pray all of our families will join in these unique events, which take so much planning and preparation, in order to celebrate the rich history and tradition of this great Parish. May God bless us all.
