A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

I pray that Lent has gotten off to a good start for everyone. This is a much needed season of spiritual renewal. I know I need it so much. I am happy that Father Innocent accepted my invitation once again this year to give a series of spiritual talks each Tuesday evening of Lent which were so well received last year. I am also looking forward to our Parish Holy Week Mission with Father Glenn Sudano of the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal and the live Stations of the Cross and Passion Play with the Procession of a 16 foot Cross up Lafayette Avenue on Good Friday. Our Lenten schedule is full with so many opportunities to make this Lent the best one yet.

At times we can look at all that is going on in our world and wonder what is wrong. In the face of many scandals in the Church, Saint Mother Theresa was once asked: "Mother, what is wrong with the Church?" And she replied: "Me. As St. Francis of Assisi exclaimed: "We adore you O Christ and we praise you, for by your Holy Cross you have redeemed the world."

We all know that our relationship with God is not what it should be, that we still have a long way to go to being the person God wants us to be. And so we are given this blessed time of Lent to begin again, to turn back to God with all our hearts. The whole point is to become holier, to become more like Jesus not just for your own sake, but for the sake of our children, our families, our Church, our Country, and our world. May God bless us all.

LENTEN SEASON 2018

Lenten Fast and Abstinence - During the Season of Lent, the Church urges all the Faithful to reflect a spirit of penance in their daily life through performing acts of fast and abstinence.

"FASTING" requires that only one full meal be taken per day. Two other smaller meals may be taken during the day to maintain physical strength, but these two meals together should not equal a full meal in quantity. Fasting obliges all those who have reached the age of 18 and continues to oblige until age 59. Those not specifically obliged to fast are encouraged to join in the discipline of fasting to the extent that they are able.

"ABSTINENCE" prohibits individuals from eating meat on a particular day. Abstinence obliges all those who have reached the age of 14 and continues to oblige throughout their entire life.

> Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are days of fast & abstinence. Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence
