## THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT MARCH 11, 2018

### A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

On this Fourth Sunday of Lent we enter into the home stretch with Palm Sunday and Holy Week only two weeks away. This Sunday is traditionally called *Laetare* Sunday, a Latin word which means *Rejoice!* The cause of our joy is what Jesus says in today's Gospel: "God so loved the world that He gave His only Son so that everyone who believes in Him might not perish but might have eternal life." We cannot save ourselves from the consequences of our sins. We cannot save ourselves from death. Only God, who is rich in Mercy, can do this for us. We need a Savior. We need Jesus.

God is Love, God is Mercy. The whole point of our lives is to receive His Love, respond to His Love, and Live in His Love. If we truly came to know and believe in the Love God has for us, we would be the happiest people on the face of the earth. But we cannot begin to understand the depths of God's Love for us without looking long and hard at the Cross and thinking about those words of Jesus: "God so loved the World that He gave His Only Son..." And His Love is not just a love for the world in general, but an intensely personal love for you and for me. As St. Augustine put it: "God loves each one of us as if there was only one of us to love."

No where do we experience this Love and Mercy of God in a more direct and personal way than in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. A good Confession makes real for us personally what Saint Paul was saying in our Second Reading: "God is rich in Mercy...because of His great love for us He brought us to life even when we were dead in sin." We leave Confession with a brand new life, a brand new start, with our souls as clean and radiant and beautiful as they were on the day of our Baptism. What a consolation it is to know that no matter where we have been or what we have done, we can always set things right with God and begin again, for God is rich in Mercy.

There are still plenty of opportunities to make a good Confession this Lent, especially at our special Holy Week Mission on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday evenings of Holy Week with Fr. Glenn Sudano of the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal to lead us into the Easter Triduum. Monday of Holy Week is also "Reconciliation Monday" when Confession will be available at every parish

throughout the Archdiocese of New York and the Dioceses of Brooklyn and Rockville Center from 3:00pm until 9:00pm. I pray that all of us will experience this Lent the depths of God's love for us in this beautiful Sacrament of Divine Mercy, so that we can arrive at Easter with the word Laetare!, Rejoice!, resounding in our hearts. "We adore O Christ and we praise You, because by your Holy Cross You have redeemed the World." May God bless us all.

## LET YOUR NEW YORK STATE SENATORS KNOW THIS IS GOING TOO FAR

In his annual budget, Governor Cuomo included a radical bill (S.7511) that would eliminate virtually all limitations on abortion in New York State. It would ensure that abortion is legal through all nine months of pregnancy, for any reason: it would allow for more lateterm abortions, even though studies show that a fetus experiences pain at 20 weeks: it would eliminate the law that requires that a baby born alive after an abortion be given adequate health care, even though as many as 5 to 10% of babies in late term abortions are born alive; it would permit non-doctors to do abortions, which would endanger the health of women; and it would eliminate all criminal penalties for abortions-so even if an abortion was against a mother's will (involuntary or coerced), or if an unborn child is deliberately targeted for an act of violence, it could not be prosecuted.

New York State already has far too many abortions. We don't need broader abortion laws. We need our law to respect human life at all stages.

This is particularly dangerous, because the law requires a budget to be passed by April 1. Please contact your state legislators to oppose this extreme bill.
