FROM OUR PRIESTS' DESKS

Dear Brothers and Sisters of Sacred Heart:

Every year right around this time our religious community gathers at Ascension Cemetery in Monsey to conduct a prayer service for the deceased members of the Augustinian Recollect Order who are buried there. It's something of a bittersweet moment when our friars put aside a few hours from their work to thank God and to pray together for our deceased brothers, many of whom we personally knew, and with whom we labored side by side in carrying out the ministry of the Church right here in Rockland County. Of course, it's all part of the larger custom of Catholics during the month of November to remember the faithful departed, the "Poor Souls" as we used to say: all of our relatives, friends, and brothers and sisters in the Catholic faith who have died, and yet whom we believe are still living through the power and love of the One who has assured us: "I am the Resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if they die, shall live forever." In affirming our belief in this promise of Jesus, we say in the Creed that we recite each Sunday that we believe ". . . in the resurrection of the dead and life everlasting."

Certainly this belief in a future life, in life beyond the grave, is one of the most consoling and reassuring aspects of our faith: that we have not permanently lost those who are dear to us and have been separated from us by death—a mother or father, a wife or husband, a close relative, or a good friend—but that this separation is only a temporary one; that we shall see them again in that place where, as the funeral liturgy says so beautifully, "we shall never lose a friend, where every tear will be wiped away, and death shall be no more." During this month of November, then, we continue to pray for all the Faithful Departed, and in doing so to place our trust in the One who has promised us an eternal dwelling place which, as St. Augustine says, is our true homeland.
