Dear sisters and brothers of Sacred Heart:

I've known by heart the first paragraph of Saint Paul's second letter to Timothy since the beginning of my priesthood...Most likely because of its frequency of being proclaimed at funeral liturgies: I HAVE COMPETED WELL. I HAVE FINISHED THE RACE. I HAVE KEPT THE FAITH...I don't know about you but there are times aplenty during my life that I've felt as though I HAVEN'T competed well or that I HAVEN'T finished the race or that I HAVEN'T kept the faith...I can't imagine there is anyone among us that hasn't had similar moments. I call it "HUMANITY 101."

Paul was a vile man before his conversion...A persecutor...He would later refer to himself, and others like him behaving badly and violently, as "the scum of the earth." But Paul bounced back resoundingly...We, too, will have disappointing days, feelings of inadequacy and lacking in faith but we also will bounce back and be good servants of the Lord and good stewards of our brothers and sisters. We can echo the words of Paul: THE LORD STOOD BY ME AND GAVE ME STRENGTH (2 Timothy).
