### FROM OUR PRIESTS' DESKS:

Dear sisters and brothers of Sacred Heart:

**The Grace of Final Perseverance.** When I reflect upon the lives of the Saints, those recognized by the Church and those simple and holy people who have been with us, I often wonder how they could endure such hardships and persecutions for our Lord Jesus. Merely reading about their lives or learning how much they have endured sufferings make me realize that I too have to prepare, like them, for whatever may come along my path. Thus, St. Paul's letter may offer us some guidance on how to do this:

2<sup>nd</sup> Letter of St. Paul to the Thessalonians

**May our Lord Jesus Christ himself & God our Father,  
Who has loved us  
And given us everlasting encouragement and good hope through his grace,  
Encourage your hearts  
And strengthen them in every good deed & word...  
May the Lord direct your hearts to the love of God  
and to the endurance of Christ.**

Fr. Adolphe Tanquerey in his writing, *The Spiritual Life*, made this beautiful reflection on this:

**"...final perseverance is a singular and priceless gift.** We cannot merit it strictly speaking. To die in the state of grace in spite of all the temptations that assail us at the last hour, to escape these by a sudden and tranquil death- falling asleep in the Lord- this is truly in the language of the Councils, the grace of graces. We cannot ask for it persistently enough. **Prayer and faithful cooperation with grace can obtain it for us.**

Another pious priest Fr. Garrigou-LaGrange thus suggested: **"Therefore, to obtain this grace of final perseverance, we should frequently unite ourselves with the Eucharistic consecration, the essence of the sacrifice of the Mass, pondering on the four ends of sacrifice: adoration, supplication, reparation & thanksgiving"** [*Providence*].

With these words, let us then constantly pray for the grace of final perseverance, embrace the love of Christ, and allow the power of His love to guide our words and actions, *all for the greater glory of God.* Amen.
