FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

FROM OUR PRIESTS' DESKS:

Dear sisters and brothers of Sacred Heart:

This beautiful Gospel passage for the 5th Sunday of Easter (Jn. 14:1-12) is taken from what we have come to know as the "Farewell Discourse" of Jesus after the Last Supper on Holy Thursday evening. It has become a favorite for use at the Rite of Christian Burial when families wish a final farewell to departed loved ones. Although it was initially addressed by Jesus to the apostles in the face of his impending death on Good Friday, it is full of the hope of Easter glory and Resurrection since it promised them—as it promises to each one of us-that Jesus' departure is not a permanent one since he is "going to prepare a place" for us in his Father's house in which there are "many dwelling places." When Jesus is asked by an anxious and still doubting Thomas what is the way we are to reach this place of blessedness Jesus responds: "I am the way and the truth and the life." We are thus assured that we can travel safely with Jesus as our companion and our guide who will lead us to God the Father most especially by our devout reception of the Sacraments, by daily prayer, and by leading good lives.

By way of contrast, our first reading (Acts 6:1-7) for today focuses on the present moment rather than the future since it speaks of the growth of the Church in this world after the sending of the Holy Spirit, and how the church is always challenged to make practical decisions about ministry to the faithful here and now. For those first Christians it involved the appointing of the seven deacons to respond to the needs of a rapidly changing Church. That decision was a good one since we still need deacons as well as our laity to carry out an important part of the mission entrusted to us by the Risen Jesus—in the liturgy, in religious education, in care to the sick and homebound, and in service to our youth, to name but a few things. As we can look to the future, then, with confidence, so we can look to the present as a time for committing ourselves to the service of our brothers and sisters in need. How we are to do this takes us back once again to Jesus who tells us that he is truly the way and the truth and the life.
