#### FROM OUR PRIESTS' DESKS:

Dear sisters and brothers of Sacred Heart:

13<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time Parish Bereavement Sunday

The Power in Baptism. Many of us were baptized as infants or children. Many of us do not remember what took place in that Sacrament. Our parents and godparents witnessed our being baptized into the "newness of life" as promised by Jesus, of being reborn in water and the Spirit: "Very truly I tell you, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless they are reborn of water and the Spirit [John 3:5]". It does not mean that because we do not remember this rebirth, just as we do not remember when we came out of our mother's womb, that we do not possess life and the life of the Spirit. This great power, the in-dwelling of the Spirit within us is what sustains us and leads us to Eternal Life. St. Paul reminds us:

#### St. Paul to the Romans 6:3...

Are you unaware that we who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? We were indeed buried with Him through baptism

we were indeed buried with Him through baptism into death,

So that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father,

We too might live in newness of life...

Consequently, you too must think of yourselves as dead to sin

And living for God in Christ Jesus.

So, in Baptism, we have already entered death, being dipped, or immersed in the water three times, symbolizing the experience of Jesus entombed in death for three days but rose again to life in His Resurrection. We too are raised, after being dipped or immersed or poured with water over our heads. We have already begun the "newness of life" which is God's gift to us in Jesus Christ. This is our great hope, this is the power we have received in Baptism, this is the great gift that will lead us to eternal life in Christ Jesus. Amen.
