Dear brothers and sisters of Sacred Heart,

The Wisdom of Death. I had a professor in college who had a human skull on his desk with a candle beside it. Amidst the piles of paper, books, and scribbled notes, he had a small prayer book in front of the human skull. I do not remember how we got into the conversation about the human skull, I just remembered that he told me, that every day, for a few minutes, he would lock his door, light the candle, and pray this novena of prayers for a holy death. He said it helps him to prepare for his own death, to order his life accordingly: to love God above all things, then to love his neighbor, and that the rest is vanity.

Surely, in this month of November, the month of the Saints and the Poor Souls, let us continue to pray for those who have gone before us, "especially those most in need of thy mercy oh Lord." By asking the intercession of the Saints and praying for the Poor Souls, we also remind ourselves that we have to prepare for our own encounter with death, as St. Paul said:

Letter to the Thessalonians 4.13-...

We do not want you to be unaware brothers & sisters about those who have fallen asleep so that you may not grieve like the rest, who have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died & rose so too will God, through Jesus, bring with Him those who have fallen asleep.

Let us then rouse ourselves with living hope in the promise of the resurrection, may death teach us to prepare our soul and to order our lives in loving God and loving our neighbor, living and deceased. Amen.
