#### Dedication of the Lateran Basilica

**Lessons from the Temple.** Whenever we hear the word "temple" we would normally think of a non-Christian structure of another faith. It may be a grandiose or simple structure, a place where a deity or deities reside according to the belief or a particular faith group. It is a particular place, a physical space for the divine wherein rituals and worship intertwine. It is a special place wherein the sacred & the mundane encounter each other, a sacred place for personal, private, and communal worship unites. The whole focus is the presence of the divine among the mortals, with the presence of a spiritual minister. Well briefly, this is what St. Paul wrote about the Christian Temple:

**1 Corinthians 3:9 -17**

**You are God's building.  
According to the grace of God...  
No one can lay a foundation  
Other the one that is there,  
Namely Jesus Christ.**

**Do you not know that you are the temple of God,  
And that the Spirit of God dwells in you?  
For the temple of God, which you are,  
Is holy.**

Let us then praise God for building His temple within us. In the **Sacrament of Baptism**, we received the Spirit of the Living God within our mortal bodies. Through the other **Seven Sacraments**, God the Father, through His Son Jesus and the gift of the Holy Spirit, has been building up His temple in each one of us. Let us keep the sacredness of that temple, let us keep the Diving Presence of the Living God within us **by genuinely loving Jesus Christ**. Let us radiate that Gift of Love in our personal & communal prayers. Let the fruits of our worship be manifested in forgiving others & works of charity & mercy. **Let us be truly God's Temple. 
