In a small hilly town of Fatima, Portugal, the Mother of Jesus, our Mother also, appeared to 3 shepherd children: **Lucia dos Santos, Francisco & Jacinta Marto**. From May 13 to October 13 Our Blessed Mother appeared to them & whispered messages to be diffused to the whole world. Since wars have been brewing in Europe, She promised peace and lasting peace if people **stopped offending Jesus, return to Him through conversion, make reparations for the sins of humanity & prayers, especially the daily recitation of the Rosary, a meditation on the life, death & resurrection of Christ.**
