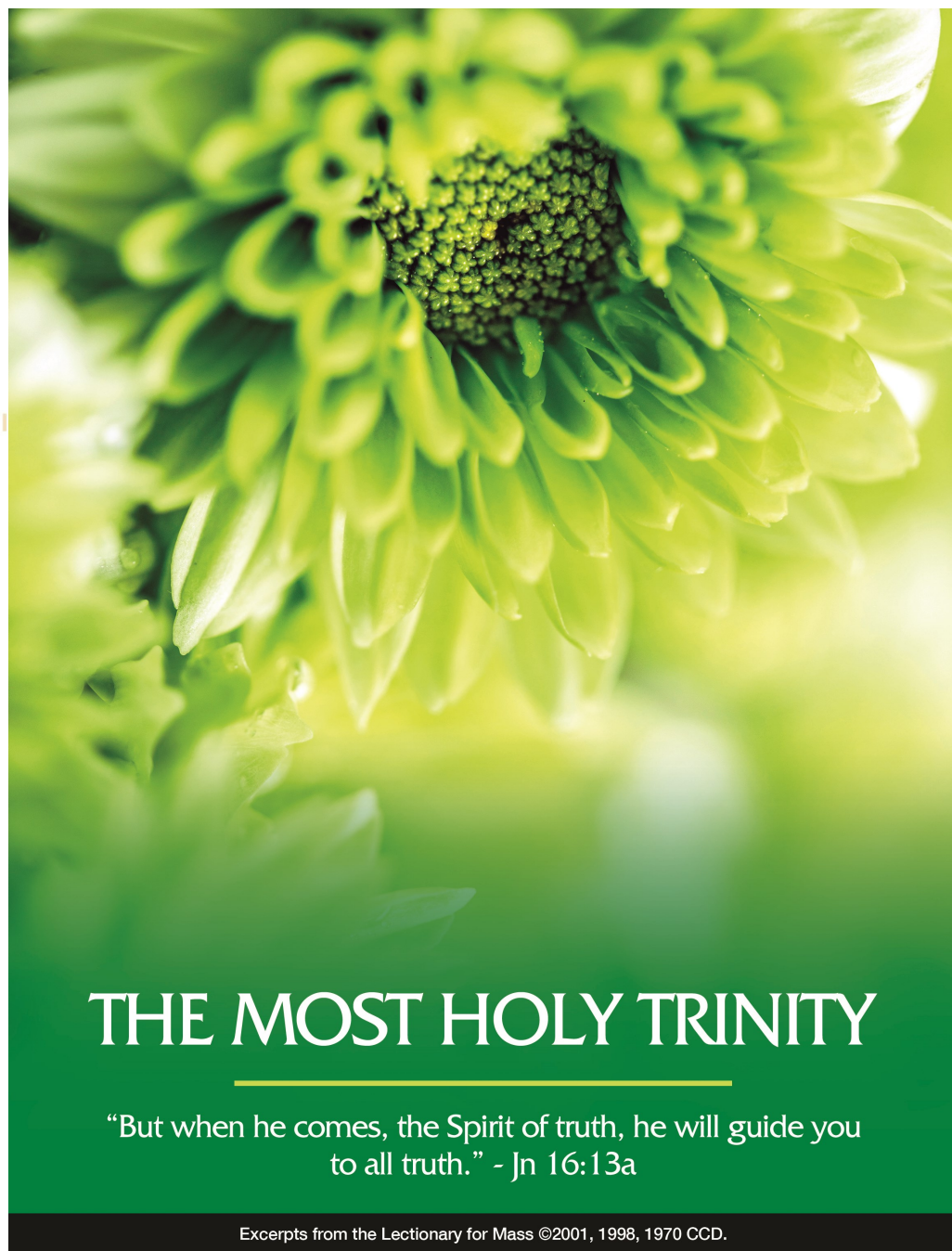

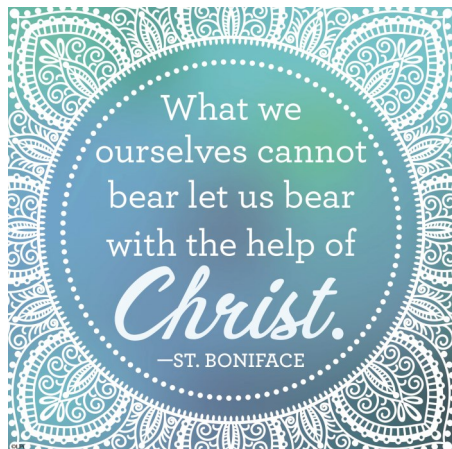

## Mass Intentions



When a priest offers Mass each day, he offers it for a particular intention, either for a special intention for a living person (honoring a birthday or anniversary, or for someone who is sick) or a memorial intention for a deceased person. Graces from God are then applied to the person.

*"The Church which is the Body of Christ participates in the offering of her Head. With him, she herself is offered whole and entire. She unites herself to his intercession with the Father for all men. In the Eucharist the sacrifice of Christ becomes also the sacrifice of the members of his Body. The lives of the faithful, their praise, sufferings, prayer, and work, are united with those of Christ and with his total offering, and so acquire a new value. Christ's sacrifice present on the altar makes it possible for all generations of Christians to be united with his offering." (Catechism of the Catholic Church 1368)*

## Farmer's Market Recipe

### Broccoli Summer Salad

1 head broccoli  
6-8 slices of bacon, crumbled  
1/2 cup chopped red onion  
1/2 cup raisins  
1 cup mayonnaise  
2 tablespoons white vinegar  
1/4 cup sugar  
salt and pepper to taste



Cut broccoli head into flowerets and the stem into bite sized pieces. Place into a large bowl, then add crumbled bacon, onion and raisins. In a small bowl, combine the remaining ingredients and stir well. Add to broccoli mixture and toss gently. Serve cool.
