#### 1. Old Business

- Joe Myers, Terrence Gallagher and Hillary Carter have accepted the invitation to join the Pastoral Council. Hillary Carter was in attendance and gave a brief introduction about herself and family.
   Father has also extended an invitation to Cheri Milligan and waiting for a response. Cheri requested some time to discuss with her family.
- Father Craig approved the 6 plan areas. Each pastoral council member is tasked with reaching out
  to their team champion to make the ask for their participation. The confirmation of those team
  champions needs to happen quickly. The next step is to recruit team volunteers to begin working
  on tasks within each of the plan areas. Large and small group gatherings will need to be scheduled
  this summer and fall.

#### 2. New Business

- Cry Room & Family Bathroom updates. It was brought to the attention of Charlotte Butler from a parishioner wanting to make some updates to the cry room and family bathroom. The hope is to make these two spaces more welcoming to families. Suggestions were new book, young children missal and baby supplies like diapers for the bathroom. Pastoral Council approved moving forward with these updates. Hillary Carter volunteered to help. Any items that need to be purchased it was advised to ask the parish before purchasing.
- Haiti Fund Request. The staff at St. Ann Church, School and YCC want to host a meal packing event
  as part of their 2023-2024 kick off event. The event costs \$7,000 and is run by Mission of Hope.
  The meals all get sent to schools in Haiti. The council approved the \$7,000 and requested more
  information on how the pallet jack is to be used to ensure the Gym floors are not damaged.
  Michaela Comstock will follow-up with Mission of Hope to check on the number of pallets and
  how they are to be moved around in the gym.
- The 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Advent falls on December 24, 2023. This means 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Advent and Christmas Eve fall on the same date. Father asked for input from Pastoral Council for adjusting morning Mass times for the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Advent. The Pastoral Council agreed that only one morning Mass is needed on Sunday morning of 12/24. The mass time will be 10 AM.
- Two women of the parish want to begin offering fellowship after every weekend Mass. Per
  discussion of the pastoral council, Suzanne Ruhlman will reach out to ask for a more detailed plan
  to address the following items; funding, volunteer structure, staff, budget. Currently treat
  weekends are very difficult to find volunteers for once a month.
- Father Craig share the following staff updates/changes. Mr. Matthew Baumler has been hired as the business manager. His first day will be May 15<sup>th</sup>. He comes from Good Shepherd in Smithville. The following position are open and looking to be filled; Catechesis of the Good Shepherd. Janet Lovick is stepping away after 11+ years coordinating. Director of Evangelization and Parish Life is open and looking to be filled. Carrie Reiser resigned from this position and her last day will be May 31<sup>st</sup>.
- Daily Mass times will change starting August 14, 2023. To add consistency with times starting
  August 14<sup>th</sup> the 8:05 AM Mass will be 8:15 AM Monday Friday. The 6:30 AM Mass will remain
  the same. Question was asked regarding Father Paul. As long as Fr. Paul is willing to celebrate the

- 6:30 AM Mass it will remain. Once Father Paul is no longer willing or able to celebrate Mass, that Mass will likely not remain.
- Spirit Night amount raised was requested to be shared to the parish. Parishioners support these nights and would like to see the amount being sent back to the school/ycc.
- Name tags were discussed. Would like to see this added and possibly include more name tags then just the greeters.
