Reading I: Malachi 1: 14b-2:2b, 8-10

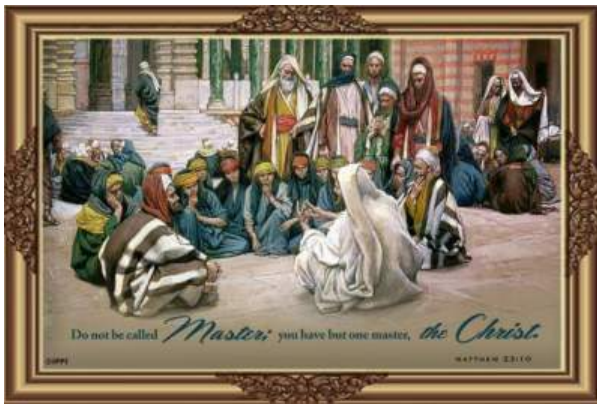
The prophet accuses the priests of disregarding God's ways, thereby leading the people astray. They had forgotten that Israel is God's extended family.
