



### TODAY THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

Reading I: Exodus 20: 1-17, or 20: 1-3, 7-8, 12-17 Yahweh asserts Himself as the only deity for Israel. Three commands pertain to Him, and seven apply to human behavior.

Paul declares that God's foolishness is a crucified Christ, and that it is far superior to human wisdom.

After angrily cleansing the Temple of any commercialism practiced there, Jesus predicts His death and resurrection. The disciples will remember His words after the Resurrection.
