The message and devotion to Jesus in The Divine Mercy is based on the writings of Saint Sister Faustina Kowalska. On February 22, 1931 at the age of 26, Jesus appeared to Sister in a white garment with red and white rays emanating from His heart. This young uneducated Polish nun received other messages from Jesus, who, in obedience to her spiritual director, recorded the revelations she received from Our Lord about God's mercy in a wrote diary of about 600 pages. During these visions, Our Lord commissioned St. Faustina to: paint and honor the Divine Mercy image, record the words of the Divine Mercy chaplet, explain and honor the Hour of Mercy – His death at 3:00pm each day, and teach us how to spread the teachings of Divine Mercy. He promised grace, forgiveness and special indulgences for this devotion.

**TODAY
FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT**

Reading I: Jeremiah 31:31-34

This short oracle has been called "one of the most profound and moving passages in the entire Bible." Note the use of the words "new Covenant." It is the only time they are used in the entire Old Testament.

Reading II: Hebrews 5:7-9

The author considers Jesus' ability to sympathize with sinners arises from the fact that He knew temptation. His obedience led to His priestly consecration.

The Gospel: John 12: 20-33

Some Greeks come to see Jesus. He tells Andrew and Philip that "when a grain of wheat dies it produces much fruit." This is a direct reference to His upcoming passion and death.
