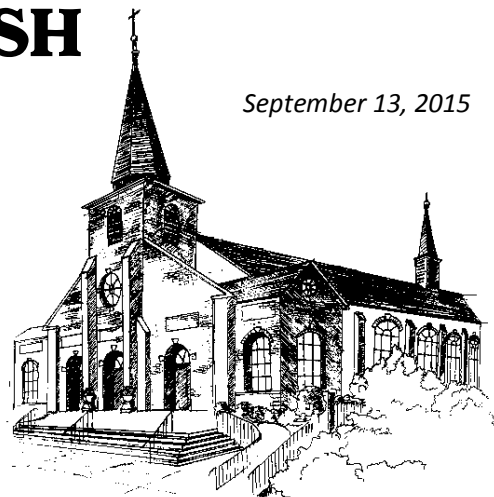

# SEPTEMBER

## A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR....

In the summer of 1929, Father James J. Halligan established the parish of Holy Name of Jesus in New Rochelle. The first parish Mass was celebrated in the Salesian High School Chapel on July 7, 1929. Despite the Depression, Father Halligan was able to finance a basement Church on Petersville Road. The Church held its first services in the original Church, now Monsignor Halligan Hall, on the second Sunday in September 1930 with just a few hundred parishioners. However, Father Halligan and his people met the challenges of their times. The people of Holy Name, with the dedicated leadership of Father Halligan, built the parish school, so vital to parish life. The school, with the Franciscan Sisters, opened in 1954. The Dominican Sisters of Sparkill, the Sisters of Charity and a wonderful dedicated lay faculty also serve or have served a vibrant school community. In 1962, Father Halligan's dream came true. The new Church was built under his guidance and through his tireless efforts. After forty years as Pastor, and now with the title of honor "Monsignor," Father Halligan retired in 1969.

Monsignor Thomas Donnelly, Monsignor John Carlin and Father Eugene O'Sullivan continued the traditions of leadership to distinguish Holy Name of Jesus Parish within the Archdiocese. The parish has had a long and proud history of providing pastoral, educational and cultural support for the Catholic community of New Rochelle and the East End.

Throughout our history, the people of Holy Name have always responded to the changing needs of our Church and faith. We have built a beautiful church and constructed and maintained an excellent elementary school for both Catholic School children and religious education (both Sunday School and RELIG) for all the youth of the Parish. Spaces for organizations and clubs, facilities for children to play and socialize and for people in general to meet and recreate, have over the years been provided for our community through the parish's generosity. In a real sense, Holy Name of Jesus Parish has been a community center for our neighborhood.

In order to maintain the level of success that we have experienced, our parish and its members have to invest in our future. We must insure that Holy Name Parish remains an integral part of the East End Community of New Rochelle. We are alive and well because of the generous response of so many good people who devote their time, talent and energy to the many activities happening in our vibrant parish. We must continue to reach out to our youth through both involvement and education. They are the hope of our parish and the treasures of the twenty-first century.

We invite new members of our parish, and all members not registered, to enroll with the form in today's Bulletin.

As we celebrate Pope Francis' visit to New York, we should be so grateful for his openness to everyone and his challenges to live and share our Christian faith.
