## **CONGRATULATIONS-DEACON BOB**

Deacon Robert Gontcharuk was appointed by the Board of Trustees of the Archdiocese of New York Central Westchester Regional Schools to be Director of Catholic Identity for the 14 Regional Schools. Cardinal Dolan initiated this new position within the Archdiocese which aims to especially address the spiritual lives and development of all the students in our catholic schools. As the Director of Catholic Identity, Deacon Bob is to collaborate with the 14 regional principals and pastors in the geographic region. The Director is to ensure that the Catholic Faith, Traditions and Values are being taught and practiced in the school curricula. Supporting active parental involvement in the spiritual lives of their children is essential if the faith and spiritual life of the child is to grow. Deacon Bob is responsible for ensuring that the Mass and Sacramental lives of the students is being attended to by all pastors and parochial vicars on a regular basis. Confession, prayer services, retreats, and catholic social action via the corporal works of mercy are integral to a catholic education. These activities are also to be encouraged in every school and require the active support of all principals, teachers, parents, priests and deacons. 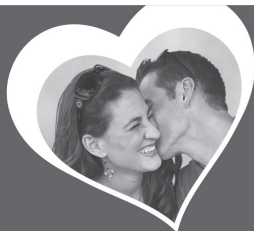

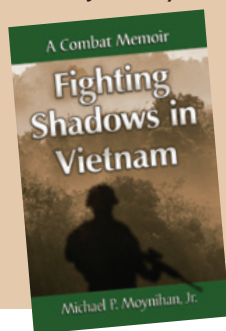

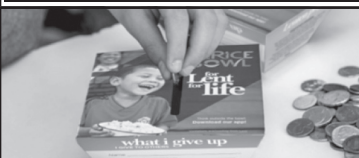
