Engaged couples should contact the Rectory at least six months in advance in order to arrange for their participation in the marriage preparation program. Please email assistantpastor@spasaparish.org.


Anointing of the Sick




Footprints

One of the most well-known modern beauty and simplicity. You've probably



Christian stories expresses this closeness of God with memorable heard of it. It's called "Footprints."

It was written in 1936 by a girl named Mary Stevenson. poverty and hardship as her father struggled to raise



One cold winter's night when she was 14-years-old, Mary was locked out of the doorstep, she wrote "Footprints" on a scrap of paper. I'd like you to read it. struggling to survive, in the cold, and writing this. And think about what God,

One night I dreamed I was walking along the beach with the Lord: Many scenes from my life flashed across the sky. In each scene I noticed footprints in the sand. Sometimes there were two sets of footprints, other times there were one set of footprints: This bothered me because I noticed that during the low periods of my life, when I was suffering from anguish, sorrow, or defeat, I could see only one set of footprints.

So I said to the Lord, "You promised me that if I followed You, You would walk with me always. But I have noticed that during the most trying periods of my life there have only been one set of footprints in the sand. Why, when I needed you most, You have not been there for me?" The Lord replied, "The times when you have seen only one set of footprints in the sand, is when I carried you."
