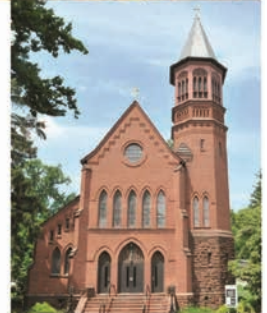

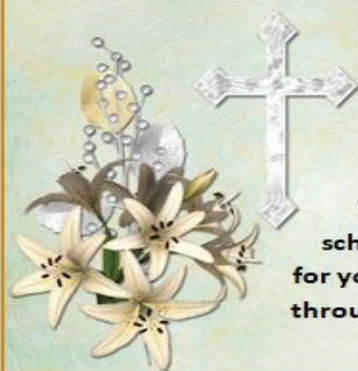

The First Sunday of Advent

ADVENT — The time of two comings!

The Advent season is a time of preparation that directs our hearts and minds to the anniversary of Our Lord's birth at Christmas, but readings of the first two Sundays direct us to prepare and contemplate another important coming — the Second Coming of Christ at the end of time.

From the earliest days of the Church, people have been fascinated by Jesus' promise to come back to us. But the scripture readings during Advent tell us not to waste our time with predictions. Advent is not about speculation. Our Advent readings call us to be alert and ready, not weighted down and distracted by the cares of this world (Lk 21:34-36). Like Lent, the liturgical color for Advent is purple since both are seasons that prepare us for great feast days. Advent also includes an element of penance in the sense of preparing, quieting, and disciplining our hearts for the full joy of Christmas.

The Many Symbols in the Advent Wreath

Maybe the most familiar and universal symbol of the beautiful message of Advent is the wreath with its four candles, which Christians have been using for more than 1,000 years.

Its **circular shape** gives it no beginning or end — perfectly symbolizing the eternity of God and His love, and the everlasting life that Christ wants to give all of us.



The different types of branches traditionally used in Advent wreaths are all from **evergreen** trees, trees that remain green even during the coldest, darkest days of winter.

They remind us that Christ's love remains fresh and strong even in life's most difficult moments — He never abandons us.

Traditional wreaths include laurel and holly branches. The **laurel branch** was an ancient symbol of victory; it reminds us that on the first Christmas Christ came to bring victory over sin and Satan. The **holly branches** are bordered with small, prickly edges, reminding us of Christ's crown of thorns, of the suffering by which He won his victory over sin and evil.

The **four candles** represent the four weeks of Advent. Some traditions also say that they represent the 4,000 years that Christians used to believe passed between the Fall of Adam and Eve and the Birth of Jesus.

Their **light** represents Christ himself, who is the light of the world: His Word shows us how we should live, and His love, expressed especially in the Eucharist, fills our hearts with comfort, like the warmth of a supernatural fire.

We light the candles gradually throughout Advent, because we know that the joy of salvation doesn't come fully into our lives all at once.

Rather, **life as a Christian is a journey**, a relationship with Jesus that has to be constantly renewed, just as a new candle is lit each week. If we are faithful to this friendship and don't abandon our journey, the fullness of joy will eventually be ours.

Christ has promised us all of this, and He wants us to rejoice in these promises, confident that since He is faithful. He can and will fulfill them.

GIVING TREE

The Advent "Giving Tree" will be in the churches the first week of Advent.

Please take an ornament and return a gift for a sister at one of our neighborhood convent infirmaries, a resident at a nursing home, or an adult or child served by one of many other organizations. Just think how this little thoughtfulness will bring joy to the people who really need to be lifted up!

Please return the gift to the tree un-wrapped with the ornament attached by Dec. 17, and we will be sure that it will be delivered to the recipient before Christmas. Thanks for your thoughtfulness!

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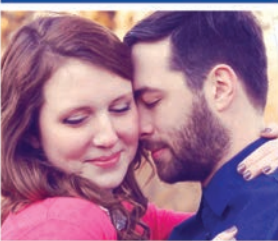
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
