





Are You "SURE" You're a Registered Parishioner?

Many times we meet people at church who attend mass, take part in events, or perhaps even have received their sacraments here. We're so very glad you're with us and part of our community. But that alone does not make you a parishioner. To be a member of the parish you have to REGISTER. Registering is very easy. You can register online at *spasaparish.org* or at the parish office. It only takes a few minutes.

Everyone over the age of 18 is encouraged to register. Even if you're an adult who received all your sacraments here as a child and still attend mass here, you need to register.

Why register? First and foremost, it's very important to register so we can serve your needs when, for example, you need a sponsor certification letter for Baptism or Confirmation. Also, to receive an acknowledgment of your donations for your income tax filing, you need to be registered so we have an official record of your giving over the year.

So, please join us officially and register with the parish so we can meet all your needs now and in the future!

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SPONSOR CERTIFICATION LETTER

In order to receive a sponsor certification letter from the Parish of St. Paul & St. Ann, you must be an <u>ACTIVE, REGISTERED PARISHIONER</u> for 6 MONTHS. IF YOU ARE NOT OFFICIALLY REGISTERED AND DO NOT ATTEND MASS, YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE A LETTER.

The role of a sponsor is to lead a Christian life in a manner that faithfully fulfills the obligations of the Catholic faith. A sponsor must be living the Catholic faith and be able to be part of the sponsored person's life after the Baptism, who can guide him/her spiritually.

A sponsor must also:

- Be at least 16 years of age
- Have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist & Confirmation
- If married, must be married according to the laws of the Catholic Church












FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



"Take it; this is my body." Then he took a cup, gave thanks, and gave it to them, and they all drank from it. He said to them, "This is my blood of the covenant, which will be shed for many."

Mark 14:22a-24

"I miss the Eucharist! I enjoy watching mass on television, but I miss the Eucharist! I turn on the tv, and I see my priests celebrating mass, but I feel it is different! It is not the same anymore." Did you feel this way back when the churches were closed last year?

During this pandemic, many parishes live-streamed the daily mass, Sunday mass, and other church services, and it was comforting for many people to be able to participate in this way. However, as time went on, many people began to admit that they really missed the Eucharist. The Eucharist is the essence of the Christian life, and it is the source of our spiritual nourishment and nurturing. It takes me back to my First Holy Communion days. I received my First Holy Communion in 6th grade, and I have strong memories of the preparation, learning the prayers, and excitement of receiving Jesus in the Eucharist for the very first time. Just think about it. I'll bet you have many memories of your First Holy Communion and that of your children and perhaps grandchildren too.

The Feast of Corpus Christi (The Body and Blood of Christ) is my favorite solemn feast of the Church. Today, we celebrate the feast of the Holy Eucharist and contemplate the mystery of the Real Presence of the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist. It is the foundation of our faith.

In the past on this feast day, many parishes organized processions of the Blessed Sacrament through the village streets. Along the way there were assigned places, beautifully decorated, for the Blessed Sacrament to be placed for a brief moment for the people to adore and worship the Lord. And then the procession would proceed to another street. Even today, many parishes have outdoor processions of the Blessed Sacrament. These processions give many Catholics an opportunity to publicly profess their faith and belief in the Real Presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament.

The Eucharist draws many people to celebrate and participate in the mystery of breaking the bread and drinking of the chalice. In my 18 years of priesthood, I've encountered thousands of people who expressed their deepest desire to be connected to the Eucharist. I also know people who have distanced and declined their participation in the Eucharist for many reasons. I tried to listen and offer reconciliation and an invitation to return. I learned that their anger is not with the Eucharistic Lord but usually with someone at their parish church or a priest.

I love to sit in the pew from time to time and participate in celebrating the Eucharist with people around me. This experience has been very humbling and powerful. One time I was in Columbus, Ohio, attending Sunday morning mass with my cousin and family. There was a young family there with three kids. The youngest was only nine months, the other baby was two, and the oldest was four years old. The mother had a bag, and it had appetizers, snacks, popcorn, books, a water bottle, and a million other things. Initially, it took me to back to my earlier days of the priesthood, feeling discomfort and annoyance. I asked myself, why does this matter so much to her? She has tolerated the looks, attitudes, and comments.

As I watched the mother, I was very impressed with her dedication and effort to introduce faith to her children. This experience helped me be welcoming and inviting to many young families with their children in church. These moments invite me to reflect and contemplate deeply on the presence of the Eucharist. Therefore, I invite you to cherish your experience with Eucharistic Lord. Why does the Eucharist matter so much to you?
