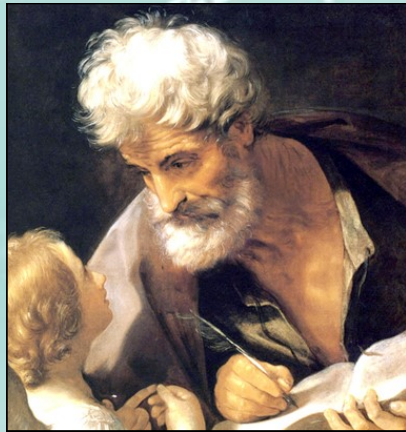

January 30, 2022 - 4th Sunday of Ordinary Time

Reading I: Jeremiah 1: 4-5, 17-19

After Jeremiah, it became a generally accepted idea that God Himself forms the young child in its mother's womb. A personal God thus knows us personally as well.

Reading II: I Corinthians 12: 31 - 13: 13, or I Cor. 13: 4-13

The immortal description of true love as understood by God. Most popular among the choices for Readings proclaimed at Nuptial Masses.

The Gospel: Luke 4: 21-30

"Today" in this context meant for all time, not just the historical time of Jesus' earthly life. Jesus becomes the "rejected prophet."
