



Dear Parishioners of Saint Matthew and Our Lady of Perpetual Help,

Thank you to the many parishioners who have reached out following my letter to you regarding Father Henry. I have also spoken with members of the Parish Council, and wanted to share the following additional information with you:

- The Archdiocese has notified law enforcement, which is now conducting an investigation.
- The Archdiocese is also conducting its own extensive financial audit.
- Both the investigation and the audit are expected to take some weeks to be accomplished.
- Meanwhile, the Archdiocese has put controls in place that require clearance for every check presented for payment.
- Preliminarily it appears that the improper application of parish funds occurred in the very recent few weeks.
- There is an insurance policy that may provide coverage; the Archdiocese has given notice to the insurance carrier.
- When more is learned we will report further.

Thank you as well for your warm welcome to Father Tuite, and for your continued prayers for Father Henry. You will have an ongoing remembrance in my own.

Reading I: Isaiah 50: 4-7

Like the prophets before him, the Suffering Servant is ignored and badly treated. Having a "face like flint" is a very effective description here because it includes the defacing spittle upon it.

Reading II: Philippians 2: 6-11

This ancient hymn Paul uses to exhort selflessness among the believers in the place. The hymn has its special beauty and emotional tug.

The Gospel of the Passion: Luke 22: 14 – 23: 56 Opening with the institution of the Eucharist, Luke's Passion account includes details galore, but above all the rejection of Jesus by the people in His crucifixion. The story ends with a kingly kind of burial.




