#### Reading I: Acts 7; 55-60

The feast of the deacon St. Stephen, our Church's first martyr, is annually celebrated the day after Christmas. Christians immediately learn that following Christ is not always "a walk in the park." So today we hear the full story of this saint's bravery.

#### Reading II: Revelation 22: 12-14, 16-17

In this "epilogue" to the vision story, Jesus gives Himself the title used to describe God, namely as the alpha and omega, the beginning and the end of all things. The Church, as a "bride," is wedded to Christ the "groom."

#### The Gospel: John 17: 20-26

Jesus "great prayer" reaches into the future to bless believers in Him of every age. He also envisions a visible unity that will speak volumes to the observant world.

### **REGISTRATION IS OPEN**

**On Friday, May 2nd and Monday, May 12th**, all families currently in the Religious Education Program received an email from Parish Giving to register their child(ren) for the 2025-2026 school year. This year, there is a registration form for **Grades 1-6** and a separate form for **Confirmation Grades 7-8**. If you have children in both grade levels, you *MUST* use both forms to register all your children. If you are new to the program, or registering a child for the first time, there is a link on the parish website to begin the registration process for *New Families*.

Registrations completed before June 30th, will receive a discount of \$100 off of tuition. Sacramental fees are not discounted.

**<u>REMINDER</u>** : All students please continue to drop your **ATTENDANCE ENVELOPES** in the collection basket each weekend when you attend Mass. If you are not able to attend Mass at STM or OLPH, please get a bulletin from the church your visiting, have it signed by the Priest, and return it in the next collection basket when you return to STMOLPH.

#### NEED A SPONSOR LETTER?

Are you going to be a Godparent or a Sponsor for Confirmation...you will need a SPONSOR LETTER.

In order to receive a sponsor certification letter from the Parish of St. Matthew & Our Lady of Perpetual Help, you must be an <u>ACTIVE, REGISTERED</u> <u>PARISHIONER</u>. To obtain a letter, please call the rectory to set up an appointment with Fr. Crawford.

The role of a sponsor is to lead a Christian life in a manner that faithfully fulfills the obligations of the Catholic faith. A sponsor must be living the Catholic faith and be able to be part of the sponsored person's life after the Baptism/Confirmation, who can guide him/her spiritually.

#### A sponsor must also:


• Be a Registered Parishioner. (Registration form can be found on the parish website: *www.stmolph.com*)

• Be at least 16 years of age & have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist & Confirmation.

• If married, must be married according to the laws of the Catholic Church.

• Attend Mass weekly and on Holy Days of Obligation.

• Live within the boundaries of the Parish.

Dear friends in the Lord:

Parishes across the country are preparing to collect an offering for the *Church in Latin America* and *The Catholic Home Missions Appeal* on June 08. Here in the archdiocese, these two collections have been combined into one.

In Latin America, because of generous people like you, many pastoral projects are reinforced both there and in the Caribbean. For the past fifty years, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops [USCCB] has helped 25 countries in Central and South America, and the Caribbean confront challenges to the faith and raise people from poverty.

Four out of ten dioceses in the United States and its territories are considered "home mission" dioceses requiring outside financial help, with small Catholic populations, limited resources, vast and often difficult terrain, and a shortage of priests and religious. Despite the challenges, the communities continue to grow in faith to serve God and neighbor and form the next generation of faithful disciples.

I count on your usual generosity again and thank you for your donation of \$297,963 in 2024 which was divided equally between these two concerns.
