WEEKLY REFLECTION FROM FATHER JOSE

This Sunday we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord. For our reflection this week let's focus our attention on the word "Epiphany." The word "Epiphany" means "Manifestation." At Epiphany God makes known to humanity His presence and all that He has in plan for our good. This Sunday we celebrate that God makes Himself known to all nations. Let's think about what the Word of God tells us about the Epiphany. The prophet Isaiah says: "Rise up in splendor, Jerusalem! Your light has come, the glory of the Lord shines upon you." In this context, the manifestation of God occurs at a crucial moment for the people of God. They are about to return from the Babylonian Exile but many of them refuse to return to their land. God makes it known that they will see His glory on their return to the Promised Land. God invites His people to seek joy and peace in the midst of fear and uncertainty. God invites His people to walk with Him so that they experience all that He can do to help them in their needs. In the Gospel we hear the wonderful story of the Magi from the East who go in search of Baby Jesus. God manifests His glory and His presence to people who do not belong to the Jewish people. God makes His presence known to all mankind through His Son Jesus Christ. The Magi from the East, guided by a star, go in search of a baby who they consider to be the king of the Jews. Let us think about the question that the Magi ask when they arrive in Jerusalem: "Where is the newborn king of the Jews?" It is a question that requires an answer. The Magi of the East are not looking for just one answer. They seek to have a personal encounter with the child that brings salvation, joy and peace. Let us now ask ourselves that same question in prayer: Where is Jesus? Jesus is present in the Eucharist, in our prayers, in each one of us. The glory of God is manifested in one and many ways in our daily life. God constantly manifests Himself in many ways. Let's get up from the comfort of our lives so that we can go together with the Magi from the East to adore Jesus. May the star of faith guide our steps so that we always seek God.

All the nations will worship you, Lord (Psalm 72).

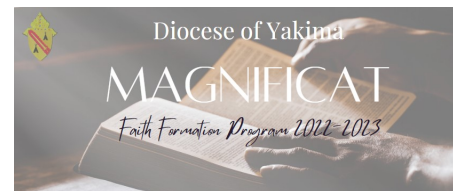

REFLEXION SEMANAL DEL PADRE JOSE

Este domingo celebramos la Epifanía del Señor. Para nuestra reflexión de esta semana enfoquemos nuestra atención en la palabra "Epifanía." La palabra "Epifanía" significa "Manifestación." En la Epifanía Dios da a conocer a la humanidad Su presencia y todo lo que Él tiene en plan para nuestro bien. Este domingo celebramos que Dios se da a conocer a todas las naciones. Pensemos en lo que nos dice la Palabra de Dios sobre la Epifanía. El profeta Isaías dice: "Levántate y resplandece, Jerusalén, porque ha llegado tu luz y la gloria del Señor alborea sobre ti." En este contexto la manifestación de Dios se da en un momento crucial para el pueblo de Dios. Están a punto de regresar del Exilio de Babilonia pero muchos de ellos se niegan a volver a su tierra. Dios da a conocer que verán Su gloria en su retorno a la Tierra Prometida. Dios invita a Su pueblo a buscar la alegría y la paz en medio del miedo y la incertidumbre. Dios invita a Su pueblo a caminar con Él para que experimenten todo lo que Él puede hacer para ayudarlos en sus necesidades. En el Evangelio escuchamos la maravillosa historia de los Magos de Oriente que van en busca de Niño Jesús. Dios manifiesta Su gloria y Su presencia a personas que no pertenecen al pueblo judío. Dios da a conocer Su presencia a toda la humanidad a través de Su Hijo Jesucristo. Los Magos de Oriente, guiados por una estrella, van en busca de un niño que consideran es el rey de los judíos. Pensemos en la pregunta que hacen los Magos cuando llegan a Jerusalén: "¿Dónde está el rey de los judíos que acaba de nacer?" Es una pregunta que requiere una respuesta. Los Magos de Oriente no buscan solo una respuesta. Ellos buscan tener un encuentro personal con el niño que trae la salvación, la alegría y la paz. Hagámonos nosotros ahora esa misma pregunta en oración: ¿Dónde está Jesús? Jesús está presente en la Eucaristía, en nuestras oraciones, en cada uno de nosotros. La gloria de Dios se manifiesta de una y muchas maneras en nuestra vida diaria. Dios se manifiesta constantemente de muchas maneras. Levantémonos de la comodidad de nuestras vidas para que vayamos junto con los Magos de Oriente a adorar a Jesús. Que la estrella de la fe guie nuestros pasos para que busquemos a Dios siempre.

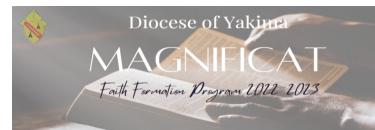
