BAPTISM: Arrangements must be made at the Rectorry. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics. Parents, and also godparents when possible, must attend the Pre-Baptismal conference which is held on the 1st Monday of every month at 6:30pm in the rectorry.

CONFESSIONS: Saturday afternoons 4:30 to 5:15 pm, and anytime at the Rectorry.

MARRIAGES: Arrangements should be made at least six months in advance at the rectorry to ensure the date and the hour desired. The Nuptial Mass is the ordinary form of celebrating Christian marriage, and should be strongly considered when making Wedding plans. Attendance at the Pre-Cana Conferences, or the equivalent, is required by the Archbishop.

PARISH BOUNDARIES: Central Park West to the Hudson River, from the South side of 77th Street down to the North side of 65th Street.

NEW PARISHIONERS: We welcome new parishioners, and invite them to register at the Rectorry. The registration is our only means of certifying anyone as a member of our parish. If you move to another Parish, or change your address within the Parish, please notify us.

FATIMA DEVOTIONS: The Rosary is said daily after the 12:10 pm Mass.

First Friday - Exposition: 12:35 pm. Adoration: All day;
Benediction: 5:15 PM.

MIRACULOUS MEDAL NOVENA: Mondays, after the 12:10 Mass

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION FOR CHILDREN AND TEENAGERS: Classes in Religion for Catholic children/teenagers, Pre- kindergarten - High School take place on Sundays. The Family Mass begins at 10:00 a.m. in the Church followed by class instruction in the school.

Ongoing religious education is important for the religious development of your children. First Communion and Confirmation require a two year program.

A man who generally sleeps in front of the western bay of the middle doors was lying there smoking a cigarette. I ask him to be careful that we didn't want a fire. On Saturday morning around 3:40 a.m. someone passed by the church and noticed that the doors of that bay were on fire. Thank God they called the fire department who came and put the fire out. Looking at the video from inside at 3:04 a.m. you can see a small light that all of a sudden burst into a roaring fire. The flames were as high as the doorway in the vestibule. How blessed are we that someone called the fire department and the swift response to put the fire out. The damage could have been catastrophic. As it is, both doors are beyond repair. We are sending them to a manufacturer to replicate the doors in keeping with the beauty of the church and standards of the Landmarks committee. We are so grateful for whoever called the fire department and to NY Bravest for their quick response and keeping our beautiful church safe.

El daño pudo haber sido catastrófico. Tal como está, ambas puertas están más allá de poder ser reparadas. Las estamos enviando a un fabricante para replicarlas de acuerdo con la belleza de la iglesia y a los estándares del comité de Monumentos Históricos. Estamos muy agradecidos a la persona que llamó al departamento de bomberos y con NY Bravest por su rápida respuesta y por mantener segura nuestra hermosa iglesia.


