CONFESSIONS: Saturday afternoons 4:30 to 5:15 pm, and anytime at the Rectory.

MARRIAGES: Arrangements should be made at least six months in advance at the rectory to ensure the date and the hour desired. The Nuptial Mass is the ordinary form of celebrating Christian marriage, and should be strongly considered when making Wedding plans. Attendance at the Pre-Cana Conferences, or the equivalent, is required by the Archbishop.

PARISH BOUNDARIES: Central Park West to the Hudson River, from the South side of 77th Street down to the North side of 65th Street.

NEW PARISHIONERS: We welcome new parishioners, and invite them to register at the Rectory. The registration is our only means of certifying anyone as a member of our parish. If you move to another Parish, or change your address within the Parish, please notify us.

FATIMA DEVOTIONS: The Rosary is said daily after the 12:00 pm Mass.

BENEDICTION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT: First Friday - Exposition: 12:35 pm. Adoration: All day; Benediction: 5:15 PM.

MIRACULOUS MEDAL NOVENA: Mondays, after the 12:00 Mass

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION FOR CHILDREN AND TEENAGERS: Classes in Religion for Catholic children/teenagers, Pre- kindergarten - High School take place on Sundays. The Family Mass begins at 10:00 a.m. in the Church followed by class instruction in the school. Ongoing religious education is important for the religious development of your children. FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - JANUARY 30TH, 2022

Dear Parishioners and Friends:

This week the Holy Father, Pope Francis, announced that he is appointing two new auxiliary bishops for the Archdiocese of New York: Father Joseph Espaillat and Father John Bonnici. Joseph Espaillat's home parish is Blessed Sacrament. It is here that he received his Sacraments and celebrated his first Mass. It was under the loving pastorate of Msgr. Robert O'Connor that Espaillat heard God calling him to the priesthood. He was ordained a diocesan priest in 2003 for the Archdiocese of New York. Prior to his becoming a priest, he obtained a Masters of Divinity degree in Theology and His Master of Arts degree in Theology (specializing in Church History) from St. Joseph's Seminary in Yonkers, NY. Fr. Joe has served as a Parochial Vicar and Pastor and was assigned in 2012 by Cardinal Dolan to be the Director of Youth Ministry for the Archdiocese of New York. Currently, he is a pastor as well as the Director of the Hispanic Catholic Charismatic Renewal Center and the Hispanic Catholic Charismatic retreat house in the Bronx. Aside from ministering the sacraments and proclaiming God's Word, Fr. Joe loves working with youth and helping them encounter Christ. Fr. Joseph enjoys spending time with family and friends as well as watching movies, writing poetry and rapping. Father has led numerous missionary trips to the Dominican Republic (his parent's homeland) and Haiti and is the founder of the ministry "Messengers of Christ". He is 45 years old and will be the youngest bishop in the U.S. and one of the youngest in the Church. We look forward to his returning to his home parish to celebrate Mass sometime this spring.

Father John Bonnici, ordained in 1991, has served as pastor at St. Columba, Chester since 2008. Prior to that, he was pastor at St. Philip Neri in the Bronx. He was director of the archdiocesan Family Life/Respect Life Office from 1996 to 2002 and served on the faculty at St. Joseph's Seminary in 1994 and 1995.

Bishops-designate Bonnici and Espaillat will be ordained to the episcopacy March 1, 2022 at St. Patrick's Cathedral.

Esta semana el Santo Padre, el Papa Francisco, anunció que nombrará dos nuevos obispos auxiliares para la Arquidiócesis de Nueva York: el Padre Joseph Espaillat y el Padre John Bonnici. La parroquia de origen de Joseph Espaillat es Santísimo Sacramento. Es aquí donde recibió sus Sacramentos y celebró su primera Misa. Fue bajo el amoroso pastorado de Mons. Robert O'Connor que Espaillat escuchó a Dios llamándolo al sacerdocio. Fue ordenado sacerdote diocesano en 2003 para la Arquidiócesis de Nueva York. Antes de convertirse en sacerdote, obtuvo una Maestría en Divinidad en Teología y una Maestría en Artes en Teología (especializada en Historia de la Iglesia) del Seminario St. Joseph en Yonkers, Nueva York. Padre Joe se ha desempeñado como vicario parroquial y párroco y fue asignado en 2012 por el Cardenal Dolan para ser el Director del Ministerio Juvenil de la Arquidiócesis de Nueva York. Actualmente, es Pastor y director del Centro de Renovación Carismática Católica Hispana y de la casa de retiro Carismática Católica Hispana en el Bronx. Además de ministrar los sacramentos y proclamar la Palabra de Dios, el P. Joe ama trabajar con jóvenes y ayudarlos a encontrar a Cristo. Padre Joseph disfruta pasar tiempo con su familia y amigos, así como ver películas, escribir poesía y rapear. El padre ha dirigido numerosos viajes misioneros a la República Dominicana (la patria de sus padres) y Haití y es el fundador del ministerio "Mensajeros de Cristo". Tiene 45 años y será el obispo más joven de los Estados Unidos y uno de los más jóvenes de la Iglesia. Esperamos que regrese a su parroquia de origen para celebrar la Misa en algún momento esta primavera.

El padre John Bonnici, ordenado en 1991, se ha desempeñado como párroco en St. Columba, Chester desde 2008. Antes, fue párroco en St. Philip Neri en el Bronx. Fue director de la Oficina Arquidiocesana de Vida Familiar/Respeto a la Vida de 1996 a 2002 y formó parte del cuerpo docente del Seminario St. Joseph en 1994 y 1995.

Los obispos designados Bonnici y Espaillat serán ordenados al episcopado el 1 de marzo de 2022 en la Catedral de San Patricio.
