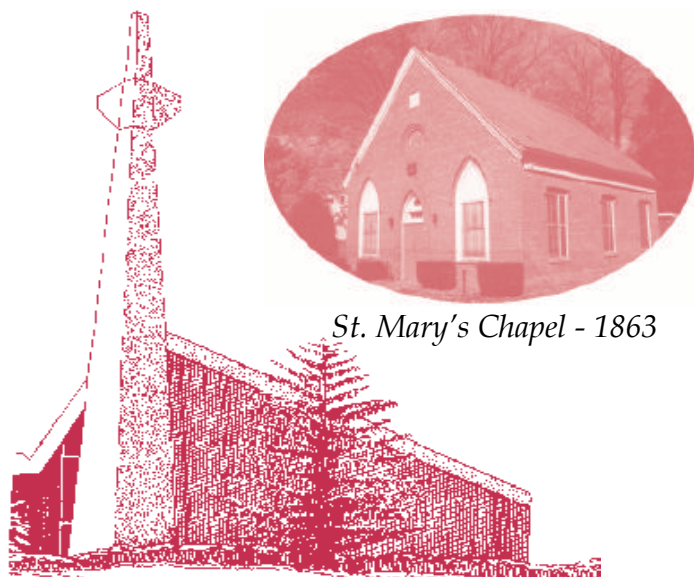

Cardinal's Appeal 2022

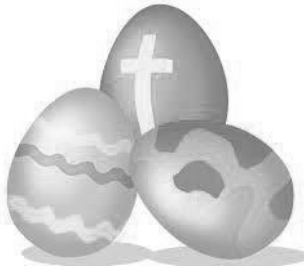
"Lord, to Whom Shall We Go?"

Thank you to the 300+ families who have donated to this year's Cardinal's Appeal. If you have not donated, **we still need your help.** We are hoping that every parish family will help in this effort. Our goal is \$138,500 and we have raised \$73,612 which puts us at roughly 53% of goal. We had a successful In-Pew Campaign, but we still have 47% more of goal to raise.

At its core, the Appeal exists to fund the vast educational, charitable, and pastoral outreach of our archdiocese, all of which serve to make Christ known in the world.

Discipleship begins with Catholic formation and is nurtured through ongoing conversion. The good work of our Catholic schools and catechetical offices is supported by the Appeal. We also share Christ's message through voice, screen and in-person communication, opening ourselves to follow Him and bring Him to others.

Celebrate God's mercy. It's a great thing to hear about God's merciful love. It's even better to experience it personally. No matter how long it may have been since your last confession -- weeks, years, or even decades -- there is no time like the start of Holy Week to know the mercy of God in the Sacrament of Penance. Seize the moment of grace at the start of Holy Week. Bring a friend. **This will be the last opportunity to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation during Lent.**

The Sunday after Easter is Divine Mercy Sunday!

Divine Mercy Sunday will be celebrated at St. Mary's on Sunday, April 24th, at 3PM in the Church. To prepare for Divine Mercy Sunday, please pray the Divine Mercy Novena which starts on Good Friday, April 15th. Novena leaflets are available in the rear of Church. Divine Mercy Service will include: Entrance and Placing of the Image of Mercy by the Knights of Columbus, the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, Divine Mercy Meditation, Veneration of the Image of Mercy with the Knights of Columbus. Jesus told St. Faustina that this Feast of Mercy would be a special day when "all the divine floodgates through which graces flow opened." (Diary 699) **"For the sake of His Sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world."**

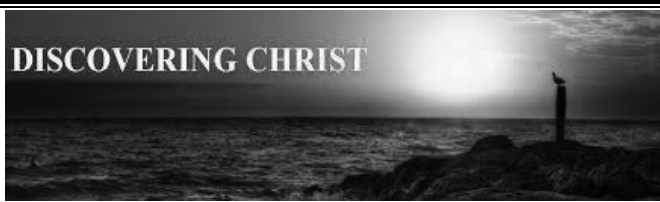

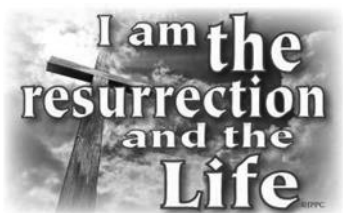
