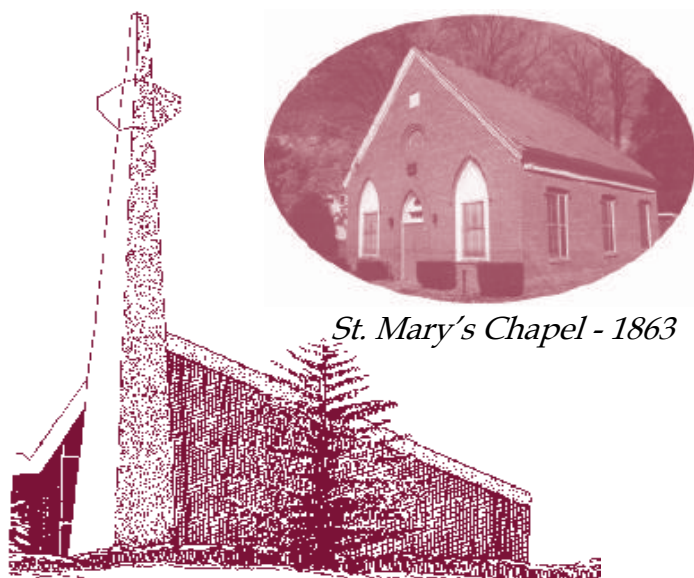

Remember St. Mary, Fishkill, in your Will



Today is Mother's Day. When I meditate about Mother's Day, I picture the scene from the movie *The Nativity* where prior to the birth of Jesus, St. Joseph and the Blessed Mother are sitting together along the bank of a river. They turn to each other and ask the deep question, "Who are we that have been chosen for this task of being the parents of God and what could we possibly teach him?"

What a very powerful question. I think that both St. Joseph and the Blessed Mother had a specific vocation in life. It would be their role to instill in Jesus that He is loved and give him memories which He would share with His closest friends. It would be Mary's vocation to create a loving, nurturing home for Jesus and to pass on the gift of faith.

Mary would be present at many of the major events and miracles in the life of Jesus and our church. She would be present at His Birth, the very First Miracle He performed at Cana, His Death and Resurrection and at the Birthday of the Church on Pentecost. I can only imagine just how difficult it had to be for her to witness our Lord's Passion. She probably thought to herself how did this all happen from a humble stable to the wood of the cross? Her heart must have been pierced just as the Prophet Simeon had foretold.

Perhaps the best lesson which Mary could have taught Jesus was the example of unselfish love. That love truly is a sacrifice! When we sacrifice our very self for the benefit of another, miracles happen. This would be Jesus' motivating force in the words He would say and the miracles and wonders He would create. The example of Mary's unselfish love and the pouring out of her heart to God would be expressed not only through her acts of kindness, but also through the way Jesus would live His life.

As we celebrate Mother's Day, may the example of the Blessed Mother also inspire the Mothers and women of our own parish community.

I would like to share with you a prayer I recently came across:

*I said a Mother's Day prayer for you
To thank the Lord above
for blessing me with a lifetime
of your tender hearted love.
I thanked God for the caring
you've shown me through the years,
for the closeness we've enjoyed
in time of laughter and of tears.

And so, I thank you from the heart
for all you've done for me
and I Bless the Lord for giving me
the best mother there could be!*

Happy Mother's Day to all of our moms, to those present with us, and to those who now pray for us in heaven.

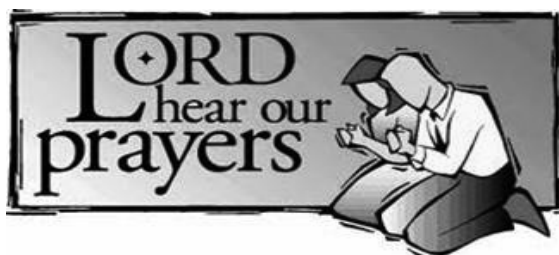

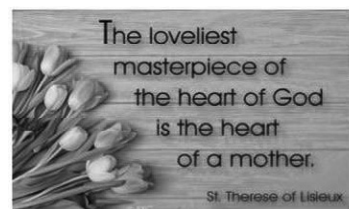
