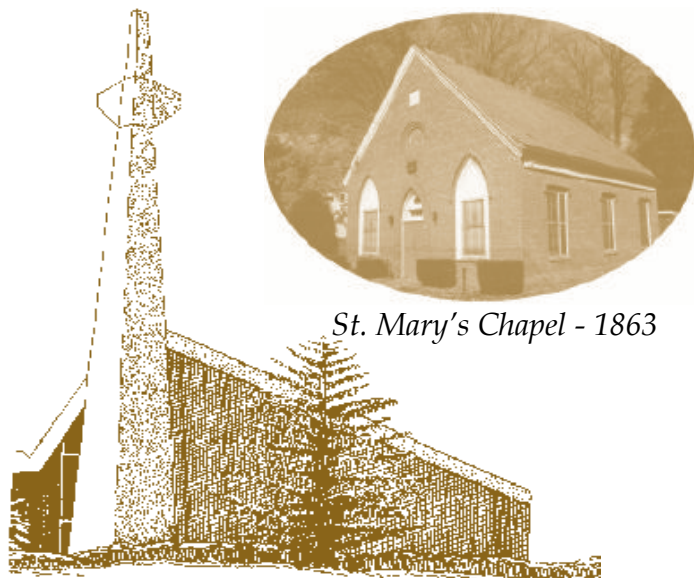

Ice cream and Camp Sponsors:

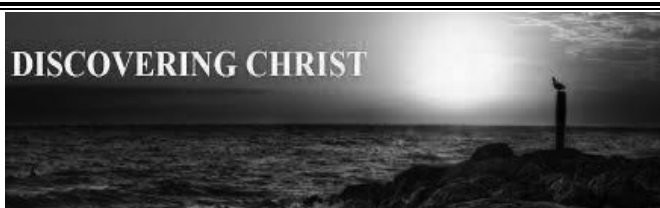
