

From the desk of our Pastor, Father Salvatore DeStefano

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

As you know, the Palm Sunday services that we celebrate this weekend are among the longest of the entire church year. I distinctly remember as a kid dreading going to church that day. I knew that I'd have to stand for a



long time and follow a long gospel to keep track of when to speak my part of it. But I knew it was important to show up for this Mass, because it was one way of showing the Lord that I could bear something unpleasant for him. In this gospel, the entire passion is played out from Palm Sunday to Good Friday.

It's truly astounding to think of what happened during that short five day period. Jesus entered Jerusalem triumphantly to a very large crowd, maybe thousands of people, all trying to get a glimpse of him. I guess you could say he was like a rock star. Five days later, the situation changed dramatically. Many of the same people who were cheering him and waving palms at him were now shouting, "Crucify Him! Crucify Him!" How fickle people can be and how fleeting fame can be.

Jesus of course knew all this. He wasn't trying to be famous and didn't care for adulation. He did what he did to save us. I sometimes wonder about the incredible rejection he must have felt. Still, it didn't stop him from completing his mission. His love for us is so great that nothing could stop him.

If you have trouble imagining this type of love, just think of the love that a mother or father has for their children. If one of the kids is seriously ill, nothing on earth could stop them from trying to save them. They'd gladly give their own life in place of their child and that's the story of the Passion. Of course, a parent's love is just a reflection of the love God has for us. God's love for us is even greater.

I never was able to understand that as a kid, standing in church during that long Palm Sunday Mass. I couldn't wait for it to be over. Now, as a pastor and spiritual father of many children, I understand it a little better. I hope you do too, and please know that God loves when you make sacrifices for him.
