Our faith reaches us that when we gather to celebrate the Eucharist, Jesus himself is present to us. Through the actions of the Mass, the bread and wine truly become the Body and Blood of Christ. This is what we mean by the word transubstantiation. Jesus makes himself present to all who receive the Body and Blood of Christ.

If there are children in your family who have already celebrated their First Communion, invite them to share their memories of this special day. If you have family photos from this occasion, bring them out and share them. Adults in the family may also share memories or photos of their First Communion. Then read together today's Gospel, John 6:51-58. Reflect together on what Jesus means when he calls himself the "living bread". Recall that every time we receive the Eucharist, Jesus keeps the promise he made in today's Gospel. Perhaps family members can share what it means for them to receive Jesus in the Eucharist. Together, thank God for this gift of Holy Communion. Pray together the Lord's Prayer or today's psalm.

**Holy Family Parish – Camp Hope Ministry**

Camp Hope residents and staff contribute to our brethren also!

The Yakima Nation Tribal Leaders asked for help from Camp Hope on dealing with their state of emergency range fire. On August 10 Camp Hope assisted the Yakima Nation in establishing an emergency shelter at the White Swan Long House. The next day the CH crew made over 200 sandwich sack lunches and delivered them to the firefighters who were able to remain on the fire line.

That evening, CH residents prepared a homemade spaghetti with Italian sausage dinner complete with green salad, Italian bread sticks, and corn on the cob. The CH residents worked very hard alongside two tribal volunteers and fed over 140 firefighters and displaced local residents a well deserved meal. Some of the White Swan residents would not leave their homes due to the concern of vandalism, so with Tribal Leader permission, the CH volunteers delivered dinner to these homes. Like us, these volunteers contributed where they could. Thank you God! And thank you Holy Family Parish-ioners!





