

Ask your children to recall games they play that involve losing or hiding something and then finding it. (Hide and Go Seek, Ghost in the Graveyard, Button, Button, Who's Got the Button?) Talk about how exciting it is to find the person or thing

Ask your children if they have any memories of losing something special or being lost themselves. Share the stories as well as the fears or feelings. Then tell them that just as you would go to any length to find and bring them home if they were lost, so too would God. That is what Jesus is telling us in the three stories. No matter what we do, no matter how wrong we are, God, our loving father, is always anxious to forgive us and welcome us back home.

## **Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:**

Soon our parishes will be conducting the Retirement Fund for Religious collection. This annual appeal benefits 30,000 elderly Catholic sisters, brothers, and religious order priests – women and men who have consecrated their lives to serving God and the Church, including our diocesan hermit, Sr. Janet Strong.

As Christians, we are called to "serve the Lord with gladness" (Ps 100:2). Our elderly religious offer a shining example of what it means to answer this call. During their days of active ministry, they worked tirelessly to build Catholic schools and hospitals, promote social justice, and embrace the neediest among us. In retirement, many continue in volunteer ministry, and all pray for the needs of our Church and world. Inspired by love, their service – past and present – is marked by joy and a deep desire to do the will of God.

As you may know, many religious communities find it increasingly difficult to provide for aging members. Most older religious worked for little or no pay. Today, their communities do not have enough retirement savings. At the same time, health-care costs continue to rise, and fewer members are able to serve in compensated ministry. Your gift to the Retirement Fund for Religious provides vital funding for medications, nursing care, and more. It also helps religious congregations plan for future retirement needs, even as they continue to serve the People of God.

In our Diocese, we are fortunate to have the ministry of prayer of Sister Janet, a professed diocesan hermit for more than 30 years who established the Beit Mery hermitage here in 1997. The hermitage is located in a small house in west Yakima, and the Diocese maintains it, and also assists with Sr. Janet's healthcare expenses.

For this reason, our annual collection for the Retirement Fund for Religious include Beit Mery Hermitage. Proceeds are being split, with half being retained by the Diocese to support the hermitage and Sr. Janet's healthcare needs, and the other half sent to the national fund. I understand you are asked to support many worthy causes. I invite you only to give what you can. Most importantly, please pray for God's continued blessing on all our women and men religious. Rest assured they are praying for you!

## Children's Ministries: PRESCHOOL -GRADE 5

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus tells us three stories about something or someone being lost and then found. When we sin, or do something we know is wrong, we turn away from God and feel lost. God never stops loving us. He looks for us when we sin. He rejoices when we return to him and tell him we are sorry. He always forgives us.
