The Great River of Faith

In the RCIA program, we are privileged to witness the mysterious process of conversion in the lives of those called to full communion with the Catholic Church, and it's an awesome sight: folks from different backgrounds and cultural settings who are at different stages of faith development, turn and are drawn into the great river of the faithful which flows down through the centuries. No one can completely comprehend this mysterious process of conversion and yet the "draw," being the Holy Spirit, is real and the results are visible. In this, conversion is like the Sacraments: a visible sign of an invisible grace or reality and, in fact, the Church is the universal sacrament of salvation, "the sign and the instrument of the communion of God and men." How is the Church the instrument of the communion of God and men? By Her liturgy and prayers, through the Deposit of Faith which includes Sacred Scripture and Sacred Tradition and by the Sacraments, through which Divine Life is dispensed to us.

During the next two months in RCIA, we are learning about the Sacraments, the very heart of our Catholic faith. My mind and prayers are on how to convey to learners the reality of the Sacraments. We ask for your prayers for us, also. Will they see that, as created beings, we are pale shadows compared with our Creator? That His life in us through the Sacraments makes us more substantial and alive and connects us with the real reality of God? That the Sacraments are channels through which we access Grace and the Divine Life lost in the Fall and restored by baptism? That with audacious generosity He allows us frequent access to this Grace in the Eucharist and Reconciliation? That the Sacraments, especially the Holy Eucharist, place the very life of Christ within us? That as He is really and substantially present in the Eucharist, we are to be His presence in this world: to feed, to heal, to bring comfort, to bring the Good News, and fitted for the more real life in the world to come? That the ordained priesthood guarantees that it really is Christ who acts in the sacraments through the Holy Spirit for the Church? That the fruit of sacramental life is both personal and ecclesial: Christ's life in each of us joins us to one another forming His body, the Church?

By Liturgy, Word, and Sacrament, the great river of the faithful flows, and in that movement we all experience conversion by our contact with Divine Life and incorporation into the river of life, the Church. *We do not remain where we entered.* With each Mass, we are further transformed, converted, renewed so that by penance and renewal the Church flows down through the ages, enriching, transforming and bringing life. Please pray for enlightenment for our Catechumens and Candidates on their journey to the river, for we who are serving as guides and for each of our own continued conversions in the flow of the great river of the faithful.



Today we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. Discuss with your family the persons of Simeon and Anna as they meet Jesus. (Luke 2: 25-40)

Because Simeon and Anna lived lives of prayer and fasting in the Temple, they were filled with the Spirit of God. That is why they were able to identify Jesus as the Savior even though Jesus was only a baby. To these two holy people, He was recognizable as the Redeemer who had been promised. Simeon described Jesus as "a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel."

We too are called to recognize Jesus as Lord. Together as a family, discuss ways to recognize Jesus as Lord by praying and attending Mass, fasting, and serving others. As a family, decide on one specific sacrifice you can make in order to alleviate the suffering or need of someone you know.
