Dear Parents and Students,

We hope you are healthy and able to cope with everything going on because of the coronavirus.

Since Religious Education in the classroom is not happening right now, this is an especially challenging time for families; and with so many other things not taking place as well, we are sure you have many questions and concerns! Please know that you have our continued support and prayers, and that our wonderful Religious Ed leaders are looking forward to welcoming your children back to the classroom as soon as it is safe to be together again.

It is very important that your children keep learning about their Catholic Faith even though we cannot meet at this time. In this mailing, we have included eight **Learning Packets** for the children in sacramental prep for First Holy Communion. Each Learning Packet is a little different, but they all contain:

- A story about our Faith for the children to read.
- A quiz, so the children can see how well they understood the story.
- A worksheet to reinforce learning.

Parents, please work with your children so that they complete all the Learning Packets. The children will be turning in the completed quiz from each Packet. We recommend that your children complete one new Learning Packet each week. This will help them remember the lessons better.

There will be a **mandatory half-day workshop** for children in sacramental prep prior to their First Holy Communion, probably in September. This required workshop will include the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Now I have a message for the children. Children, there are four things you should be doing right now.

1. If you are in sacramental prep for your First Holy Communion, read and complete all the **Learning Packets** included with this letter.
2. Watch **Mass every** Sunday if you have a smartphone or access to the Internet on a computer. You can also watch Mass on television at noon every Sunday on these stations: CW9 Channel 29.2, Charter Channel 9, Dish Channel 33, or DirecTV Channel 20. The Mass is super important because Jesus is right there in the Holy Eucharist. If it is not possible to watch Mass, then read the Gospel and write about what you think Jesus is saying to you in your Mass Journal.
3. Keep filling out your **Mass Journal** every Sunday. We will be collecting your Mass Journals the next time we meet.
4. **Pray** for your family and for your teachers and for our Church and for an end to this bad virus. Please do your best to learn the Our Father and Hail Mary. You will want to pray these beautiful prayers your whole life!

The COVID-19 outbreak is impacting not only our liturgies and gatherings but even the donations that we normally receive through the offertory. 
