

It is not only individuals who need reassurance about God's love and protection. Communities need this reassurance as well, including the community of the family. Children rely on the confidence of their parents for this assurance. Parents can help the entire family's growth in trust and confidence in God by witnessing ways in which daily family needs are entrusted to God's care.

As the family gathers, distribute pieces of paper to each person. Tell them to write or draw ways in which they believe that God's help is needed for each person and for the family as a whole. Each slip of paper can then be collected in a basket.

Invite one member of the family to read aloud today's Gospel, Matthew 10:26-33. Recall together how well God knows your family and thank God for this wonderful grace. Conclude by praying together for each of the needs identified on the slips of paper. After each need is read, pray together, "God, we trust you because you know us so well." Conclude by praying the Glory Be to the Father.

This practice might become a regular part of your family's prayer. Set the basket in a place of prayer and encourage family members to add other needs throughout the week. Perhaps your family can pray for these things together during a family meal.





#### A note from the Youth Minister

As you all know, due to the outbreak of COVID-19 and its unfortunate coincidence with my maternity leave, we had to suspend youth programming at Holy Family through the end of the 2019-2020 school year. I would like to take a moment to extend my apologies to the youth community for this abrupt break. I have missed all of you, and I am so sad that we are unable to resume our normal programming!

However, due to the wonders of technology, we are set and ready to launch our revised SUMMER 2020 Online Youth Group access! There are two main weekly events that we will run this summer.

- 1. For all high school participants, incoming freshmen through graduating seniors: I would like to invite you to participate in Global Life Nights! This is a weekly YouTube live stream event put on by the team from LifeTeen. The live stream begins at 2pm every Sunday afternoon, and a recorded video is available on the LifeTeen channel afterwards. At 6:00PM every **SUNDAY EVENING** I will host a meetup on Zoom for us to catch up and discuss the topic of the week. All you have to do is watch the livestream (or catch the video afterwards) and then hop on Zoom! Links to the Zoom meetings will be shared on Remind.
- 2. For all middle school youth our summer programming will continue on Wednesday evenings at 6:30PM, also over Zoom. I will attach a separate letter with some additional details about how this ministry will work.

As the summer progresses and the COVID-19 pandemic continues to unfold, we will continue to re-evaluate our programming and will update you with any changes. We miss you! I promise to do everything I can to best serve our community during this challenging time.

## Introducing: remind

## Holy Family Youth Ministry's new communication system

Starting Summer 2020, we are introducing a new communication system for the youth ministry program! We will be using a program called Remind. Remind has the benefit of allowing for easy mass communication, and gives you the opportunity to keep your contact information private if you wish.

#### What to do:

- 1: Go to Remind.com and enter the email address or phone number you wish to be contacted through. This information is encrypted, and is not available to Hannah, or anyone else using the service.
- 2: You will be sent a 4-digit code to verify the phone number or email address you have entered. Type that code into the box provided and press continue.

- 3: You will be prompted to enter your first and last name, and a password. This is the name that will appear in the system, so please use your real name! Your password can be anything you want.
- 4: Select your role. Remind was designed for school use, so teens, you will register as a student. If you are under the age of 13, for safety reasons, please do not register and have a parent register instead!
- 5: Enter our class code, which is hfyyouth
  6: That's it! You will receive text messages or
  emails with real time updates for schedule
  changes, upcoming events, weather or other youth
  group cancellations, reminders when you have
  signed up for service, and more!


