



Not only can we recognize family members' voices, we can also read the tone of their voices and know something about how they are feeling. In our relationship with Jesus, we know Jesus' voice and are called to follow. Jesus doesn't just bring us closer to the Father, Jesus puts us directly into contact with God the Father, removing all distance between us. In the Gospel of John, Jesus identifies so closely with the Father that he tells us that they are one—not just close, but actually one. Knowing Jesus means knowing the Father.

Read with your family today's Gospel, John 10:27-30. Ask your family members to talk about some ways that Jesus brings them closer to God and closer to one another. Pray together the Acts of Faith, Hope, and Love.







"Behold your mother" (John 19:27)

On the Cross, Jesus gave us everything, including His mother to be our mother (John 19:27). We don't worship Mary because she isn't God but we do give her special honor in imitation of Jesus' love for her (Luke 2:51). We can:

Call her "Mom." When we are baptized into the Church, Mary becomes our mother by grace (CCC #197), and we can address her with confidence and affection as her children. Mary wants the best for us. She always leads us to her Son by the guickest and safest route. Learn from her. Want to know how to follow Christ faithfullydaily? Mary was the first-and the perfect-Christian. She continually trusted God and followed His will, and tells us, "Do whatever he tells you" (John 2:5).

Ask her for prayers. Christ is the one Mediator (1Timothy 2:5). However, she also receives our prayers for others. Because she is His mother and the Queen of Heaven, Mary's prayers are

powerful. She will keep praying for us until we are in Heaven.




Dear Holy Family Friends, As you know Holy Family Church has a mission of helping the homeless at Camp Hope. We have fed the people twice weekly over the past






